## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

## 3. SETUP

---

2. **Device Recognition:** Your operating system (Windows, macOS, Linux) will automatically detect the new hardware. A notification may appear, indicating that the device is ready for use. The flash drive will typically appear as a removable disk in 'My Computer' (Windows) or 'Finder' (macOS).

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 4.1. Transferring Files

- **Copying Files To:** Open the flash drive's folder. Drag and drop files or folders from your computer into the flash drive's window, or copy and paste them.
- **Copying Files From:** Drag and drop files or folders from the flash drive's window to a location on your computer, or copy and paste them.

### 4.2. Safely Removing the Device

To prevent data corruption, always safely remove the flash drive before physically disconnecting it.

- **Windows:** Click the 'Safely Remove Hardware and Eject Media' icon in the system tray (bottom-right corner of the taskbar), then select the HP USB device. Wait for the 'Safe to Remove Hardware' message before unplugging.
- **macOS:** Drag the flash drive icon from the desktop or Finder sidebar to the Trash icon, or right-click (Control-click) the icon and select 'Eject'. Wait for the icon to disappear before unplugging.
- **Linux:** Right-click the device icon on your desktop or file manager and select 'Eject' or 'Unmount'.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

- **Physical Care:** Keep the flash drive clean and free from dust and moisture. Avoid exposing it to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight.
- **Data Protection:** Regularly back up important data stored on the flash drive to another storage medium.
- **Connector Protection:** When not in use, ensure the USB connector is protected from damage.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

- **Device Not Recognized:**
  - Try plugging the flash drive into a different USB port on your computer.
  - Restart your computer.
  - Ensure your operating system is up to date.
- **Slow Transfer Speeds:**
  - Ensure you are using a direct USB port on your computer, not a USB hub.
  - Close other applications that might be using system resources.
  - Large numbers of small files can transfer slower than a single large file of the same total size.
- **Data Corruption:**
  - Always use the 'Safely Remove Hardware' function before unplugging the drive.
  - Avoid disconnecting the drive during a file transfer.
  - If data appears corrupted, try running a disk check utility on your computer.
