Fossil Men's Bronson Quartz Stainless Steel Chronograph Watch FS5852 User Manual

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your new Fossil Men's Bronson Quartz Stainless Steel Chronograph Watch, Model FS5852. This guide provides essential information on setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your timepiece to ensure optimal performance and longevity. Please read these instructions carefully before using your watch.

COMPONENTS OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the main components of your Fossil Bronson watch:

- **Crown:** Used for setting the time and date.
- **Pushers:** Buttons located on either side of the crown, primarily used for chronograph functions.
- **Dial:** The watch face displaying time, sub-dials, and date window.
- **Hands:** Hour, minute, and second hands, often with luminescent accents.
- **Sub-dials:** Smaller dials on the main face for chronograph minutes, seconds, and 24-hour time.
- **Case:** The main body of the watch, made of smoke gray stainless steel.
- **Band:** Smoke gray stainless steel bracelet with a fold-over clasp.

SETUP

1. Setting the Time

1. Pull the crown out to position 2.
2. Rotate the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to move the hour and minute hands to the correct time.
3. Push the crown back into position 0 to start the watch.

2. Setting the Date

1. Pull the crown out to position 1.
2. Rotate the crown to adjust the date.
3. Once the correct date is displayed, push the crown back into position 0.

3. Adjusting the Chronograph

The chronograph features three sub-dials for tracking minutes, seconds, and 24-hour time.

1. Press the top pusher to start the chronograph.
2. Press the top pusher again to stop the chronograph.
3. Press the bottom pusher to reset the chronograph hands to zero.

4. Adjusting the Band

The stainless steel bracelet links can be removed for a customized fit. It is recommended to have this adjustment performed by a professional jeweler or watch repair service to prevent damage to the band or clasp.

OPERATING THE WATCH

Timekeeping

Your watch is powered by a precise Quartz movement, ensuring accurate timekeeping. The main hands display the current hour, minute, and second.

Chronograph Function

The chronograph allows for precise timing of events. The sub-dials indicate elapsed time in seconds, minutes, and a 24-hour format. Refer to the 'Adjusting the Chronograph' section for operation.

Water Resistance

This watch is water-resistant up to 50 meters (165 feet) or 5 ATM. This rating means it is suitable for short periods of recreational swimming and showering. It is **not** suitable for diving or snorkeling. Avoid operating the crown or pushers while the watch is wet or submerged to prevent water ingress.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

To maintain the appearance of your watch, wipe the case and crystal with a soft, damp cloth. For the stainless steel band, a soft brush with mild soap and water can be used, ensuring to rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

Battery Replacement

The watch uses one product-specific battery. When the watch stops running or the time becomes inaccurate, it may be time for a battery replacement. It is highly recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure the water resistance seal is properly maintained.

Storage

When not wearing your watch, store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. The original Fossil watch tin (see Figure 4) provides excellent protection.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Watch not running:** Check if the crown is fully pushed in (position 0). If it is, the battery may need replacement.
- **Time inaccuracy:** If the watch is consistently running slow or fast, the battery may be low, or the movement may require servicing.
- **Chronograph hands not resetting to zero:** This may indicate a need for calibration or servicing.

To ensure a comfortable fit, refer to the general case size guide below. The 44mm case of your Bronson watch is considered a large size.

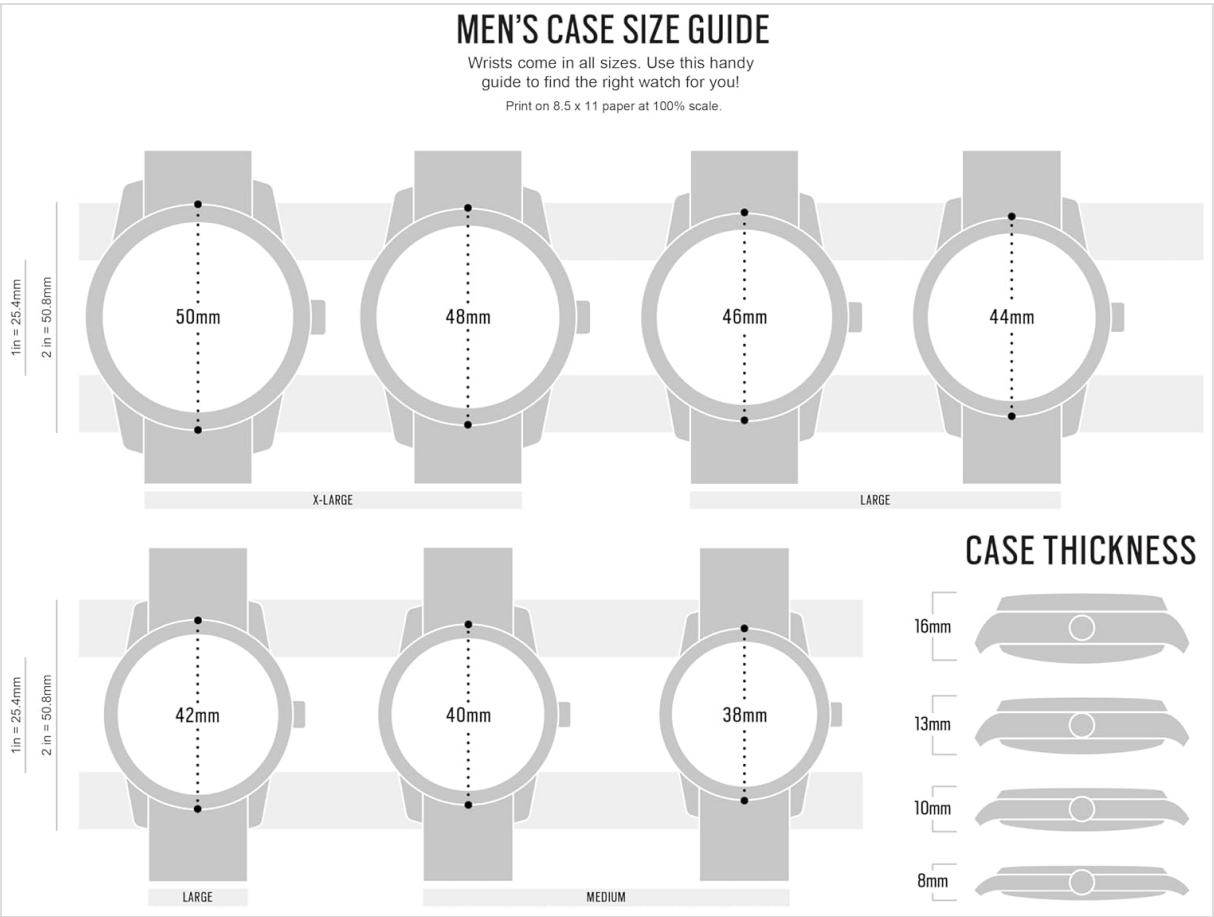


Figure 5: Men's watch case size guide, illustrating different watch diameters and case thicknesses for reference.







WARRANTY AND SUPPORT
