INTRODUCTION

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Ensure the power supply matches the specifications listed on the appliance.
- Do not immerse the power cord, plug, or any part of the appliance in water or other liquids.
- Keep the appliance away from heat sources and direct sunlight.
- Use only potable water for ice production.
- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or when not in use for extended periods.

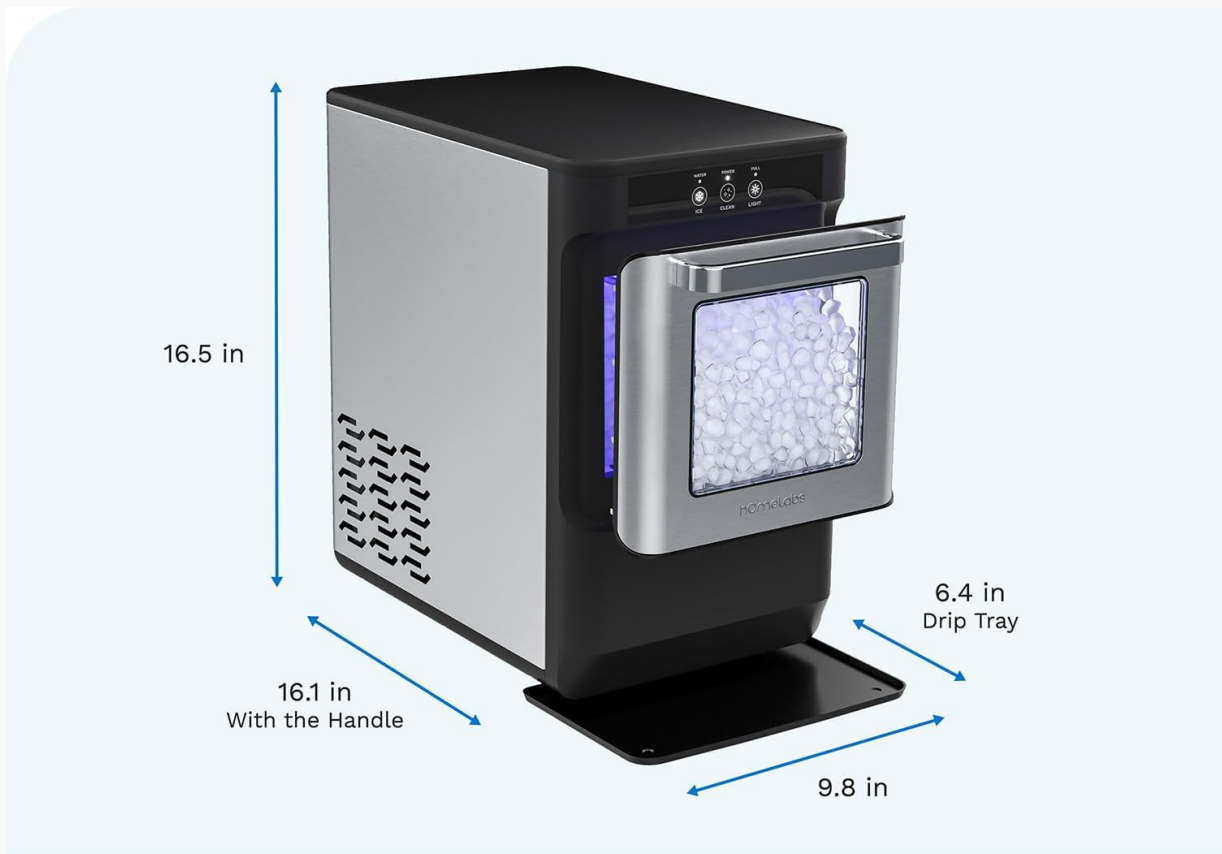

SETUP

1. Unpacking and Placement

Carefully remove the ice maker from its packaging. Place the unit on a stable, level surface away from

direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit, especially at the back and sides. The dimensions of the unit are approximately 19.3"D x 11.9"W x 17.7"H.

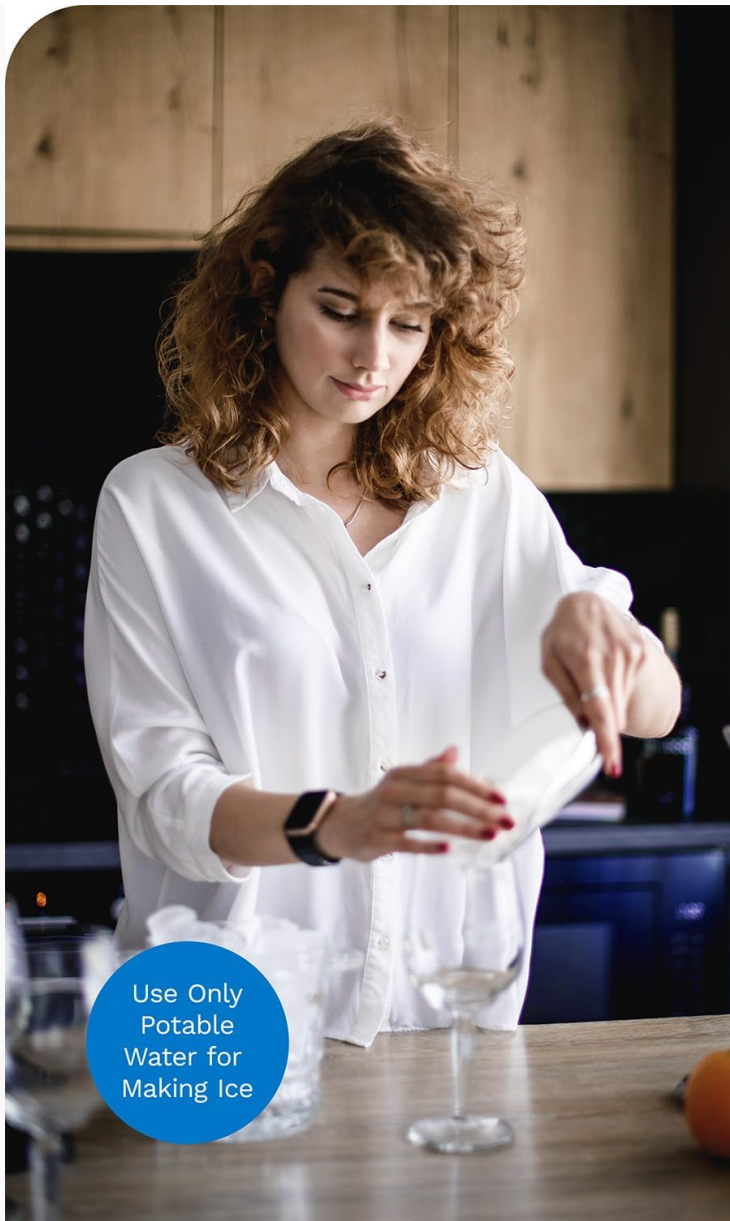

2. Initial Cleaning

Before first use, clean the ice maker thoroughly. Refer to the 'Maintenance' section for detailed cleaning instructions. It is recommended to run a cleaning cycle before making ice for consumption.

3. Water Filling

Locate the water tank. Remove the ice bucket to access the water reservoir. Fill the 2.2 L (0.58 Gallon) tank with potable water up to the 'MAX' line. Do not overfill. Replace the ice bucket securely.

Control Panel Overview

CONTROL PANEL

Easy to Operate

Simple LED Touch Control Panel

- **WATER Indicator:** Illuminates when the water reservoir is low and needs refilling.
- **POWER Indicator:** Shows the unit is powered on and operating.
- **FULL Indicator:** Illuminates when the ice bin is full.
- **ICE Button:** Press to start or stop the ice making cycle.
- **CLEAN Button:** Press to initiate the self-cleaning cycle.
- **LIGHT Button:** Press to turn the internal blue LED light on or off.

Making Ice

1. Ensure the unit is plugged into a grounded electrical outlet.
2. Fill the water reservoir with potable water as described in the 'Setup' section.
3. Press the 'ICE' button to begin the ice making process. The 'POWER' indicator will illuminate.
4. The ice maker will automatically produce nugget ice. The first batch may take slightly longer.
5. When the ice bin is full, the 'FULL' indicator will light up, and the unit will pause ice production.
6. Remove ice as needed using the provided scoop. The unit will resume ice production once ice levels drop.

MAINTENANCE

Regular Cleaning

Regular cleaning is crucial for maintaining the performance and hygiene of your ice maker. It is recommended to clean the unit weekly or before first use.

1. Unplug the ice maker from the power outlet.
2. Remove the ice bucket and drip tray. Wash them with warm, soapy water, rinse thoroughly, and dry.
3. To activate the self-cleaning cycle, ensure the water reservoir is filled, then press the 'CLEAN' button. The cycle typically runs for 20 minutes.
4. After the cleaning cycle, drain any remaining water from the unit.
5. Wipe the interior and exterior surfaces with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Rinse with clean water and dry thoroughly.

Draining

To drain the unit, locate the drain plug at the bottom or back of the ice maker. Place a basin underneath and remove the plug to allow water to drain completely. Once drained, replace the plug securely.

Storage

If storing the ice maker for an extended period, ensure it is completely drained and dry. Store it in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not producing ice.	No water in reservoir; unit not plugged in; ambient temperature too high.	Fill water reservoir; ensure unit is plugged in; move to a cooler location.
'WATER' indicator is on.	Water level is low.	Add water to the reservoir.
'FULL' indicator is on.	Ice bin is full.	Remove ice from the bin.
Ice tastes strange or has odor.	Unit needs cleaning; stale water.	Perform a thorough cleaning cycle; use fresh, potable water.
