SETUP

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound or low volume	Cable not fully connected Audio source volume too low Incorrect audio source selected Faulty cable	Ensure cable is securely plugged into both headphones and audio source. Increase volume on your audio device. Verify the correct audio output is selected on your device. Try a different audio cable if available.
Distorted sound	Volume too high Poor audio source quality Damaged cable	Reduce volume on your audio device. Test with a different audio source or higher quality audio files. Inspect the cable for damage; replace if necessary.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headphones uncomfortable	Improper fit	Adjust the headband and earcup position for a comfortable, secure fit.
