## SETUP

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution to wipe the surface of the mouse. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Optical Sensor:** Periodically check the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse for dust or debris. Clean gently with a cotton swab if necessary.
- **Cable Care:** Avoid sharply bending or twisting the USB cable to prevent internal damage.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your HP 125 Wired Mouse, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mouse not responding	Loose USB connection, faulty USB port, driver issue.	Ensure the USB cable is securely plugged into a USB port. Try plugging the mouse into a different USB port on your computer. Restart your computer.
Cursor movement is erratic or jumpy	Dirty optical sensor, unsuitable surface, software interference.	Clean the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse. Use the mouse on a clean, non-reflective, opaque surface (e.g., a mouse pad). Check for any conflicting software or background processes.
Buttons or scroll wheel not working	Software issue, physical damage.	Restart your computer. Test the mouse on another computer to determine if the issue is with the mouse or the computer.
