PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Homelegance Lexicon Lunar Twin Over Full Bunk Bed is designed to maximize sleeping space. This contemporary metal bunk bed features a twin-sized top bunk and a full-sized bottom bunk, constructed with a durable tubular metal frame in a dark bronze finish. It includes guard rails for the top bunk and a sturdy ladder for access.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before assembly and use. Failure to follow these instructions can result in serious injury.

- **Age Restriction:** The top bunk is not to be used by children under 6 years of age.
- **Guard Rails:** Always ensure guard rails are properly installed and secured on the top bunk to prevent falls.
- **Ladder Safety:** Use the provided ladder for accessing the top bunk. Ensure the ladder is securely attached before use.
- **Weight Limits:** Do not exceed the recommended weight limits for each bunk. (Specific weight limits are not provided; refer to manufacturer's website if available).
- **Mattress Size:** Use only mattresses of the specified size to ensure proper fit and safety with guard rails.
- **Prohibition of Play:** Bunk beds are not play equipment. Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed.
- **Loose Parts:** Periodically check all connections and tighten hardware as needed.
- **Proposition 65 Warning:** This product may contain chemicals known to the State of California to

cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm.

PARTS AND HARDWARE

Before beginning assembly, ensure all components are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly. Contact customer support for replacement parts.

Typical Components Include:

- Headboard and Footboard frames
- Side rails for both twin and full bunks
- Support slats or mesh for mattress foundation
- Ladder components
- Guard rails for the top bunk
- Connecting hardware (bolts, nuts, washers, Allen wrench)

Note: Tools are not provided. You will typically need a Phillips head screwdriver and possibly a rubber mallet for assembly.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Adult assembly is required. It is recommended to have two adults for assembly. Clear a large area for assembly and keep all hardware out of reach of small children.

1. **Unpack and Identify:** Carefully unpack all components and lay them out on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratching. Identify each part using the provided parts list (if applicable).
2. **Assemble Lower Bunk:** Begin by attaching the side rails to the headboard and footboard of the full-sized lower bunk. Secure all connections loosely at first.
3. **Install Lower Bunk Foundation:** Place the mattress support slats or mesh foundation onto the lower bunk frame. Ensure it is securely seated or bolted into place.
4. **Assemble Upper Bunk:** Repeat the process for the twin-sized upper bunk, attaching side rails to its headboard and footboard.
5. **Install Upper Bunk Foundation:** Secure the mattress support slats or mesh foundation for the upper bunk.
6. **Attach Guard Rails:** Install the guard rails to the top bunk frame, ensuring they are firmly attached to prevent movement.
7. **Stack Bunks:** Carefully lift the assembled upper bunk and place it onto the lower bunk frame. Align the connecting points and secure them with the appropriate hardware. This step requires at least two adults.
8. **Attach Ladder:** Securely attach the ladder to the designated points on the bunk bed frame.
9. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place and aligned, go back and securely tighten all bolts and fasteners. Do not overtighten.
10. **Inspect:** Before use, thoroughly inspect the assembled bunk bed to ensure all connections are tight and stable.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Proper use of the bunk bed ensures safety and longevity.

- **Top Bunk Access:** Always use the provided ladder to access the top bunk. Do not climb on the frame or other furniture.
- **Guard Rail Function:** The guard rails are designed to prevent falls from the top bunk. Ensure they are always in place and secure.
- **Weight Distribution:** Distribute weight evenly on both bunks. Avoid concentrating weight in one small area.
- **Mattress Placement:** Ensure mattresses are properly seated within the frame and do not extend above the guard rails on the top bunk.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help preserve the condition and safety of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the metal frame with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) inspect all bolts, screws, and connections. Tighten any that have become loose. Do not overtighten.
- **Structural Integrity:** Check for any signs of wear, damage, or bending in the metal frame. If damage is found, discontinue use and contact the manufacturer for advice.
- **Ladder and Guard Rails:** Ensure the ladder and guard rails remain securely attached and are not

bent or damaged.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your bunk bed, refer to these common solutions.

- **Bed Wobbles:** This is typically caused by loose hardware. Re-tighten all bolts and fasteners, ensuring the bed is on a level surface.
- **Squeaking Noises:** Squeaking can result from loose connections or friction between metal parts. Identify the source of the squeak and tighten the corresponding hardware. A small amount of silicone spray (avoiding mattress areas) can sometimes help if friction is the cause.
- **Difficulty Assembling:** Ensure you are following the instructions step-by-step. Verify that all parts are correctly oriented and that you are using the correct hardware for each connection. Do not force parts together.
- **Missing Parts:** If parts are missing upon unboxing, do not proceed with assembly. Contact Homelegance customer support for assistance.
