INTRODUCTION

This user manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Scheppach TIGER5000S Wet Grinding System with Homekit. Please read this manual thoroughly before initial use to ensure proper handling and to achieve optimal sharpening results.

SETUP

1. Unpacking and Component Check

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Verify that all parts are present and undamaged. The package should include:

- · Scheppach TIGER5000S Wet Grinding System unit
- Corundum grinding stone (200mm diameter)
- · Leather honing wheel
- · Polishing paste
- · Angle gauge
- Universal device 70
- Homekit (sharpening devices 40 and 60)

2. Filling the Water Tank

The TIGER5000S features a large, unbreakable water tank essential for cooling the grinding stone and preventing overheating of the workpiece. Fill the tank with clean water before operation. Ensure the water level is sufficient to keep the grinding stone wet during use.

3. Power Connection

Connect the power cable to a standard 230 Volt AC outlet. Ensure the power switch is in the 'off' position before plugging in the unit.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. General Operation

The Scheppach TIGER5000S is equipped with a powerful 150W induction motor, driving a 200mm diameter corundum grinding stone (220 grit) and a 200x30mm leather honing wheel at a speed of 115 revolutions per minute. This combination ensures precise and efficient sharpening.

2. Using the Angle Gauge

The included angle gauge is crucial for setting the correct sharpening angle for your tools. Proper angle setting ensures optimal sharpness and extends tool life. Place the tool in the appropriate sharpening device and use the angle gauge to verify the angle against the grinding stone.

3. Sharpening with Universal Device 70 and Homekit

The universal device 70 is suitable for sharpening many straight standard tools. The Homekit includes specific sharpening devices (40 and 60) designed for various stone sharpening applications. Secure your tool firmly in the chosen device before grinding.




Image: The universal device attached to the grinding system, ready for sharpening various straight tools.

4. Honing with the Leather Wheel and Polishing Paste

After grinding, use the removable leather honing wheel to remove any burrs and achieve a perfectly polished edge. Apply a small amount of the included polishing paste to the leather wheel for best results. This step refines the edge and enhances sharpness.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning

Regularly clean the machine after use. Wipe down the exterior with a damp cloth. Ensure no grinding residue accumulates in the water tank or around the grinding stone.

2. Grinding Stone Care

Over time, the grinding stone may become uneven. Use a flattening stone (if available or recommended by Scheppach) to re-true the grinding stone surface, ensuring consistent sharpening results.

3. Water Tank Maintenance

Empty and clean the water tank regularly to prevent algae growth and accumulation of grinding particles. Use clean water for each sharpening session.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Scheppach TIGER5000S, consider the following common solutions:

- **Machine not starting:** Check if the power cable is securely plugged into a working outlet. Ensure the power switch is in the 'on' position.
- **Grinding stone not running true:** Ensure the grinding stone is properly secured and tightened. If it still wobbles, the stone may need to be re-trued using a flattening stone.
- **Poor sharpening results:** Verify that the correct sharpening angle is set using the angle gauge. Ensure the grinding stone is sufficiently wet and clean. The tool might require more passes or a different sharpening technique.
- Excessive burr: Ensure you are using the leather honing wheel with polishing paste after grinding to remove burrs effectively.
