## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the Bellemave Wooden House Bunk Bed. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, proper use, and maintenance of your new bunk bed. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

This twin over twin bunk bed features a unique house-shaped frame and a low-profile design, making it a safe and engaging sleeping solution for children. The lower bed is positioned close to the floor, enhancing safety for younger users.

## 2. SAFETY WARNINGS

---

**WARNING:** Failure to follow these safety instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- Ensure that the combined weight on the upper bed does not exceed **250 lbs.**
- Ensure that the combined weight on the lower bed does not exceed **350 lbs.**
- Always use the built-in 3-step ladder for accessing the upper bunk.
- Ensure that the guardrails around the upper bunk are securely in place at all times to prevent accidental falls.
- The lower bed is designed to be on the floor, offering a safer choice for young children.
- Always follow proper assembly instructions to prevent instability or collapse of the bed structure.
- Do not allow children under 6 years of age on the upper bunk.
- Use only mattresses that are 6 inches thick for the upper bunk and 8-10 inches thick for the bottom bed.
- Periodically check and tighten all fasteners.

- Do not jump on the bed.
- Keep the area around the bed clear of obstructions.
