1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing a Hotpoint Ariston appliance. This user manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, installation, and maintenance of your BCB 4010 E Low Frost Combined Refrigerator. Please read these instructions carefully before using the appliance and keep them for future reference.

The Hotpoint Ariston BCB 4010 E is a combined refrigerator with a freezer compartment at the bottom, designed for optimal food preservation with its Low Frost technology. It features a total capacity of approximately 400 liters and an energy efficiency rating of F.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure the appliance is unplugged before performing any cleaning or maintenance.
- Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.
- Do not use electrical appliances inside the food storage compartments, unless they are of the type recommended by the manufacturer.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Keep ventilation openings, in the appliance enclosure or in the built-in structure, clear of obstruction.
- Do not store explosive substances such as aerosol cans with a flammable propellant in this appliance.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove all packaging materials. Dispose of packaging responsibly, keeping plastic bags and other materials away from children.

3.2 Placement

Place the refrigerator on a firm, level surface. Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance. Do not install it near heat sources (e.g., ovens, radiators, direct sunlight) or in excessively damp places. Refer to the installation diagram for recommended clearances.

3.3 Electrical Connection

Connect the appliance to a properly grounded electrical outlet. Ensure the voltage and frequency match the specifications on the rating plate. Do not use extension cords or multiple adapters.

3.4 Initial Startup

After installation, wait at least 2-3 hours before plugging in the appliance to allow the refrigerant to settle. Once plugged in, set the temperature control to a medium setting and allow the refrigerator to cool for several hours before loading food.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Temperature Control

The refrigerator's temperature is controlled via an internal panel. Settings typically range from 'Low' to 'High', corresponding to warmer to colder temperatures. Adjust the setting based on ambient temperature and food load. The control panel may also include indicators for various functions.

4.2 Food Storage

Organize food efficiently to ensure proper air circulation and temperature maintenance. The refrigerator compartment features adjustable shelves and door bins for versatile storage. The freezer compartment at the bottom is equipped with drawers for frozen items.

4.3 Fresh Zone

The 'Fresh Zone' drawer is designed to maintain optimal humidity and temperature for storing fruits and vegetables, helping to keep them fresh for longer.

4.4 Low Frost Technology

This appliance features Low Frost technology, which significantly reduces ice build-up in the freezer compartment compared to conventional static freezers. This means less frequent manual defrosting is required, making maintenance easier.

5. Maintenance and Cleaning

5.1 General Cleaning

Clean the interior and exterior of the refrigerator regularly with a soft cloth and a mild detergent solution. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents. Ensure all surfaces are dry before reconnecting power.

5.2 Defrosting

While Low Frost technology reduces ice formation, occasional manual defrosting of the freezer compartment may still be necessary. To defrost, unplug the appliance, remove all food, and allow the ice to melt naturally. Collect melted water and dry the interior thoroughly before restarting.

5.3 Door Seals

Regularly check and clean the door seals to ensure they are free from food debris and maintain a tight seal. A damaged or dirty seal can lead to inefficient operation and increased energy consumption.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Appliance not cooling:** Check if the power cord is properly plugged in. Ensure the temperature control is not set to 'Off' or a very warm setting. Verify that the circuit breaker has not tripped.
- Excessive noise: Ensure the appliance is level and not touching any walls or cabinets. Check for loose items inside.
- Water on the floor: Check if the drain hole in the refrigerator compartment is blocked. Ensure the drip tray (if applicable) is correctly positioned.
- **Door not closing properly:** Check for obstructions, ensure shelves and bins are correctly placed, and inspect door seals for damage or dirt.
