Rollei Wireless Remote Control for Canon

Model: 28118

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Rollei Wireless Remote Control, Model 28118. This device is designed to provide remote shutter release and advanced timer functions for compatible Canon cameras, enhancing your photographic capabilities, especially for long exposures, time-lapses, and self-portraits.

Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure correct operation and to prevent damage.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in your package:

- Rollei Wireless Remote Control (Transmitter)
- Rollei Wireless Receiver
- Connection Cable for Canon Cameras
- Batteries (pre-installed or included separately)
- Instruction Manual (this document)

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your Rollei Wireless Remote Control system.

3.1. Transmitter (Remote Control)

- **LCD Display:** Shows program settings, timer values, and battery status.
- **Shutter Button (HOLD):** Press halfway for autofocus, fully for shutter release. Can be locked for continuous shooting or long exposures.
- **Directional Buttons (Up, Down, Left, Right):** Navigate menus and adjust settings.
- **SET Button:** Confirms selections.

- **Back Button:** Returns to the previous menu or cancels an action.
- **Play/Forward Button:** Advances through menu options or programs.

3.2. Receiver

- **Hot Shoe Mount:** Attaches to the camera's hot shoe for secure mounting.
- **Connection Port:** For connecting the cable to the camera's remote port.
- **Indicator Light:** Shows connection status and operation.

4. SETUP

4.1. Battery Installation

The remote control and receiver require batteries for operation. Ensure batteries are inserted with correct polarity.

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of both the transmitter and receiver.
2. Open the compartment cover.
3. Insert the required batteries (typically AAA for the remote, and a smaller cell for the receiver, as indicated by the device markings) according to the polarity indicators (+/-).
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

4.2. Connecting to the Camera

The receiver connects to your Canon camera's remote control port.

1. Mount the receiver onto your camera's hot shoe. Ensure it is securely fastened.
2. Connect one end of the provided connection cable to the receiver's port.
3. Connect the other end of the cable to the remote control port on your Canon camera. The location of this port varies by camera model; refer to your camera's manual if needed.

4.3. Pairing the Transmitter and Receiver

The remote control and receiver are typically pre-paired. If they do not connect automatically, follow these steps:

1. Ensure both the transmitter and receiver have fresh batteries and are powered on.
2. Refer to the specific pairing instructions in the included quick start guide or on the device itself, as pairing procedures can vary slightly. Generally, this involves pressing a pairing button on both units within a short timeframe.
3. The indicator light on the receiver will confirm a successful connection.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Rollei Wireless Remote Control offers various modes for shutter release and advanced timing functions.

5.1. Basic Shutter Release

1. Ensure the remote and receiver are connected and the camera is powered on.
2. Press the **Shutter Button (HOLD)** on the remote halfway to activate autofocus (if your camera is set to AF).
3. Press the **Shutter Button (HOLD)** fully to trigger the camera's shutter.

5.2. Timer and Intervalometer Functions

The remote's display allows you to program various shooting sequences, such as delay, exposure time, interval, and number of shots.

1. Use the **Directional Buttons** (Up/Down) to navigate through the different settings on the LCD display (e.g., Delay, Exposure, Interval, N (number of shots)).
2. Press the **SET Button** to select a setting for adjustment.
3. Use the **Directional Buttons** (Up/Down/Left/Right) to change the values for the selected setting.
4. Press **SET** again to confirm the value.
5. Once all desired settings are configured, use the **Play/Forward Button** to start the programmed sequence.
6. To stop a sequence, press the **Back Button** or the **Shutter Button (HOLD)**.

Note: Specific programming steps may vary. Refer to the on-screen prompts and the quick start guide for detailed instructions on setting each parameter.

5.3. Locking the Shutter (Bulb Mode)

For very long exposures (Bulb mode on your camera), you can lock the shutter button on the remote.

1. Set your camera to Bulb mode.
2. Press the **Shutter Button (HOLD)** fully and slide it upwards (or in the indicated direction) to lock it in the depressed position.
3. The shutter will remain open for the duration you desire.
4. To end the exposure, slide the **Shutter Button (HOLD)** back to its original position.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your remote control.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the remote and receiver. Do not use liquid cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the device in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. If storing for extended periods, remove the batteries to prevent leakage.
- **Handling:** Avoid dropping the device or subjecting it to strong impacts.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Remote does not power on.	Check battery installation and ensure batteries are fresh. Replace if necessary.
Camera does not respond to remote.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure the receiver is properly connected to the camera's remote port.◦ Verify the receiver is powered on and paired with the remote.◦ Check camera settings to ensure external remote control is enabled.◦ Ensure the remote is within the 10-meter operating range.◦ Replace receiver batteries.

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Timer functions are not working as expected.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Double-check all programmed settings (Delay, Exposure, Interval, N).◦ Ensure the camera is in the correct shooting mode (e.g., Bulb for long exposures).
Display is dim or unresponsive.	Replace the batteries in the remote control.


