1. INTRODUCTION

2. SETUP

2.1 Unboxing and Initial Power On

Carefully remove your ThinkPad X1 Yoga Gen 5 and its accessories from the packaging. The box typically includes the laptop, a power adapter, and a stylus.

- Connect the power adapter to the laptop and a power outlet.
- Press the power button to turn on the device.
- Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial Windows 10 Pro setup.

2.2 Port Overview

The ThinkPad X1 Yoga Gen 5 features a variety of ports for connectivity.

- **Left Side:** Two Thunderbolt ports (USB-C compatible), one USB-A 3.2 Gen 1 port, and one HDMI 2.0 port.

- **Right Side:** One USB-A 3.2 Gen 1 port and a combined headphone/microphone jack.

3. OPERATING YOUR DEVICE

3.1 Convertible Modes

The ThinkPad X1 Yoga Gen 5 is a 2-in-1 convertible laptop, allowing it to be used in various modes:

- **Laptop Mode:** Standard laptop use with keyboard and touchpad.
- **Tent Mode:** Ideal for presentations or watching media.
- **Stand Mode:** Screen facing outwards, keyboard tucked away.
- **Tablet Mode:** Screen folded back completely for touch-only interaction.

3.2 Touchscreen and PenPro

The 14.0" FHD (1920 x 1080) touchscreen supports multi-touch gestures and input from the included PenPro stylus. The screen features Privacy Guard for enhanced visual security and an IR camera for facial recognition login.

3.3 Keyboard and Fingerprint Reader

The backlit keyboard provides comfortable typing in various lighting conditions. The integrated fingerprint reader allows for secure and quick login.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a screen cleaner to clean the display. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- Wipe the keyboard and chassis with a soft, dry cloth.

4.2 Cooling System

The laptop is engineered with dual fans and rear venting to maintain optimal operating temperatures. Ensure that the vents are not obstructed to prevent overheating.

- **No Power:** Ensure the power adapter is securely connected and the outlet is functional. Try a different power outlet.
- **Display Issues:** Restart the laptop. If using an external monitor, check the cable connections.
- **Slow Performance:** Close unnecessary applications. Check for system updates.
- **Touchscreen Unresponsive:** Restart the device. Ensure the screen is clean and free of debris.
