MoKo Apple Pencil 1st Gen USB-C Adapter Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

This MoKo USB-C adapter is specifically designed for charging the Apple Pencil 1st Generation and enabling Bluetooth pairing with the iPad 10th Generation and iPad A16 (11th Generation). It offers a convenient, cable-free solution for maintaining your Apple Pencil's power and connectivity. The adapter features a robust design with advanced safety measures to protect your device during charging, and its ultra-lightweight, compact form factor ensures excellent portability.

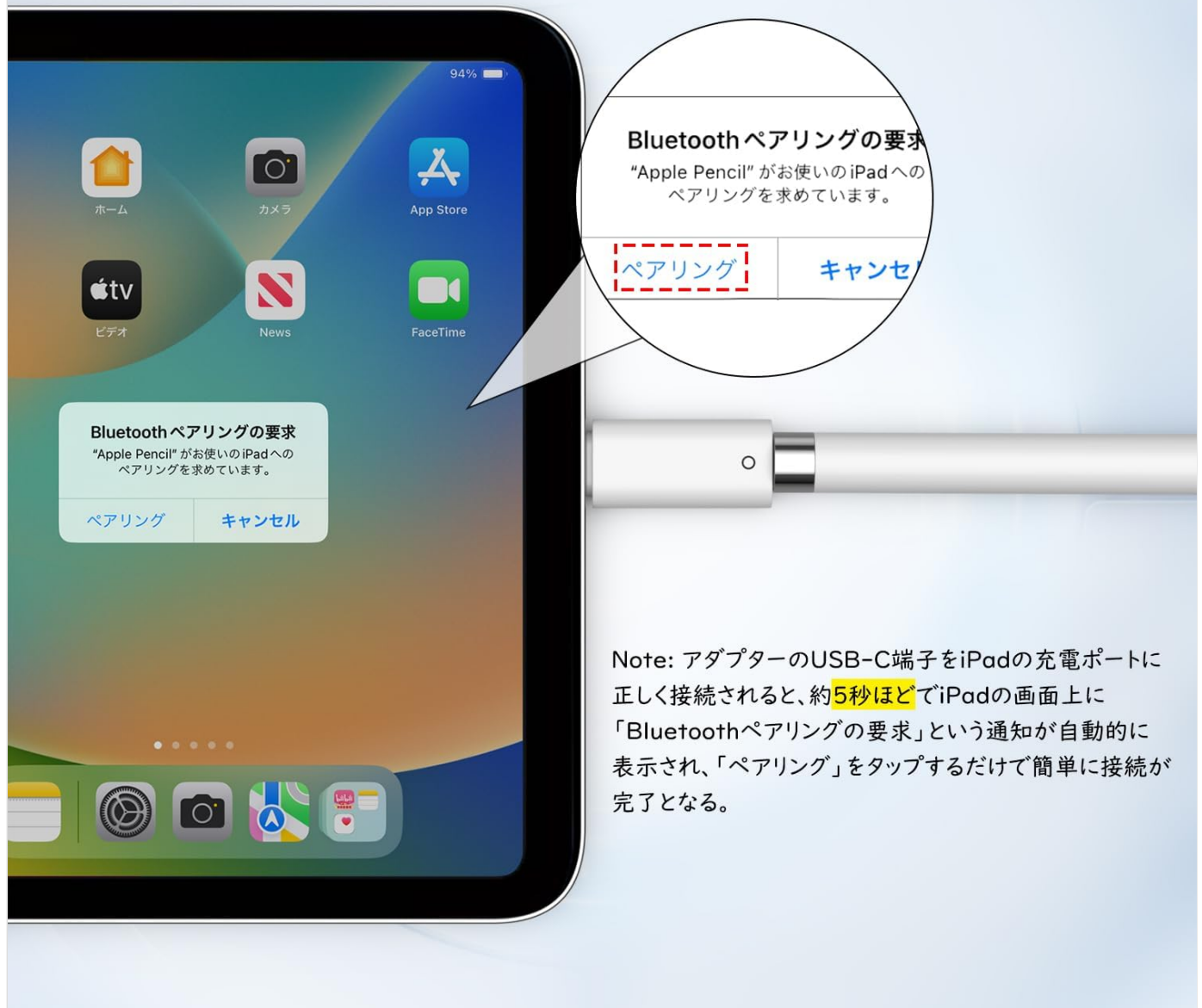
Important Note: This product is exclusively for Apple Pencil 1st Generation charging and pairing with the specified iPad models. It does not support data transfer, audio output, Lightning cable conversion, or general Type-C power supply to other devices.

SETUP: BLUETOOTH PAIRING

Follow these steps to pair your Apple Pencil 1st Generation with your compatible iPad using the MoKo USB-C adapter:

1. **Enable Bluetooth:** On your iPad, navigate to Settings and ensure Bluetooth is turned on.
2. **Connect Adapter:** Firmly connect the USB-C end of the adapter into your iPad's charging port.
3. **Connect Apple Pencil:** Connect your Apple Pencil 1st Generation to the Lightning end of the adapter.
4. **Pairing Request:** Approximately 3-5 seconds after a correct connection, a "Bluetooth Pairing Request" notification will automatically appear on your iPad screen.
5. **Confirm Pairing:** Tap "Pairing" on the notification to complete the connection.

Troubleshooting Tip: If the pairing notification does not appear, disconnect the adapter from your iPad and re-insert it firmly.

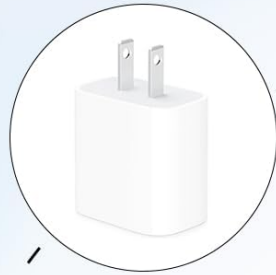
OPERATION: CHARGING YOUR APPLE PENCIL

The MoKo USB-C adapter allows for direct and hassle-free charging of your Apple Pencil 1st Generation. No additional cables are required.

1. **Connect Adapter to Power Source:** Insert the USB-C end of the adapter into a compatible USB-C power source. This can be your iPad 10th Gen / iPad A16 (11th Gen), a USB-C AC adapter, a mobile battery, or a laptop with a USB-C port.
2. **Connect Apple Pencil:** Connect your Apple Pencil 1st Generation to the Lightning end of the adapter.
3. **Charging Begins:** Charging will commence automatically. The adapter's design ensures stable pairing with your iPad even while charging, allowing you to monitor the charge status at any time.

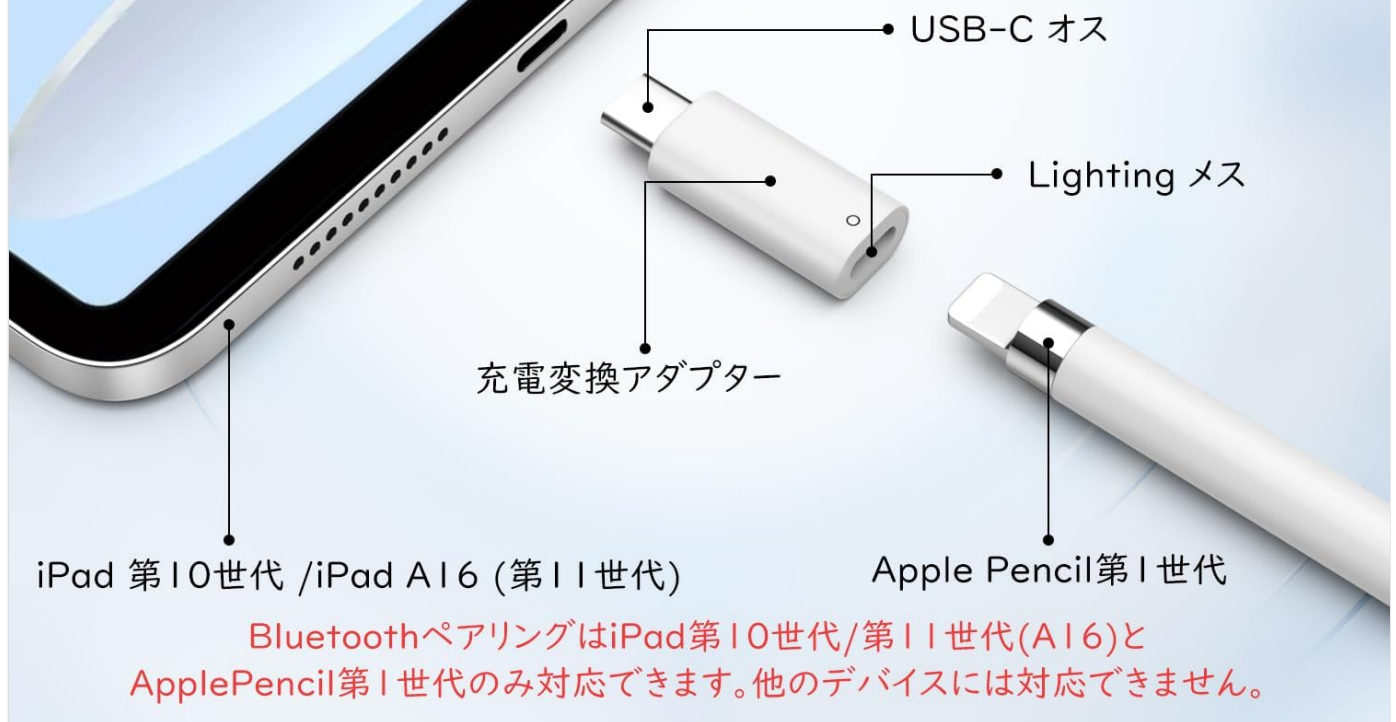


Image: Detailed view of the adapter connecting an Apple Pencil 1st Gen to an iPad's USB-C port.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to gently wipe the adapter. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the adapter in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Handling:** Avoid dropping the adapter or subjecting it to strong impacts. While durable, excessive force can cause damage.
- **Connector Care:** Ensure the USB-C and Lightning connectors are free from dust and debris before use to ensure optimal connection.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Apple Pencil Not Charging:**
 - Ensure both the USB-C end of the adapter and the Apple Pencil are firmly and correctly inserted.
 - Verify that your USB-C power source (iPad, AC adapter, etc.) is functioning correctly and providing power.

- Check if the Apple Pencil itself is working correctly when connected to other compatible charging methods (if available).

• **Bluetooth Pairing Fails or Notification Doesn't Appear:**

- Confirm that Bluetooth is enabled on your iPad.
- Disconnect the adapter from your iPad and Apple Pencil, then re-insert both firmly.
- Ensure your iPad model is either the 10th Generation or iPad A16 (11th Generation). This adapter is not compatible with other iPad models for pairing.
- Restart your iPad and try the pairing process again.

• **Adapter Feels Loose in iPad Port:**

- Ensure the adapter is pushed in completely. Some users have reported needing to push firmly until it clicks into place.
- Check the iPad's USB-C port for any obstructions or debris.
