INTRODUCTION

SETUP

1. Initial Charging

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge your MX Keys Mini for Mac. Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the keyboard's USB-C port and the other end to a power source (e.g., computer USB port or USB wall adapter).

2. Pairing with Your Device

The MX Keys Mini for Mac connects via Bluetooth Low Energy. It can be paired with up to three Apple devices (macOS, iOS, iPadOS).

- 1. Turn on the keyboard using the power switch located on the right side.
- 2. Press and hold one of the Easy-Switch keys (F1, F2, or F3) for three seconds until the LED indicator above the key starts blinking rapidly. This indicates the keyboard is in pairing mode.
- 3. On your Mac, iPad, or iPhone, go to System Settings (or System Preferences) > Bluetooth.
- 4. Select 'MX Keys Mini for Mac' from the list of available devices and follow the on-screen prompts to complete the pairing.
- 5. Once paired, the LED indicator will glow solid for 5 seconds and then turn off.


3. Installing Logitech Options Software (Optional but Recommended)

Smart Keys

The keyboard includes dedicated Smart Keys to enhance your workflow:

- Dictation Key: Press to activate talk-to-text functionality.
- Emoji Key: Instantly opens your emoji window.
- Mic Mute/Unmute Key: For seamless control during video calls.

Smart Illumination (Backlighting)

The keys light up the moment your hands approach and automatically adjust to suit changing lighting conditions, conserving battery life. You can manually adjust backlight brightness using the dedicated keys (F5 and F6).



Multi-Device Switching

Easily switch between up to three paired devices by pressing the F1, F2, or F3 Easy-Switch keys. The keyboard will instantly connect to the selected device.

Logitech Flow Compatibility

When paired with a Flow-enabled Logitech mouse (e.g., MX Master 3 for Mac or MX Anywhere 3 for Mac), you can type on multiple devices in one fluid workflow. This allows you to transfer files, documents, and images across Apple devices by simply moving your cursor from one screen to another.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

To clean your keyboard, use a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Avoid excessive moisture and harsh chemicals.

Battery Care

The MX Keys Mini for Mac is equipped with a LiPo rechargeable battery. Battery life can last up to 10 days on a full charge with backlighting enabled, or up to 5 months with backlighting turned off. To prolong battery life, avoid extreme temperatures and store the keyboard in a cool, dry place when not in use for extended periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Keyboard Not Connecting via Bluetooth

- Ensure the keyboard is turned on and fully charged.
- Verify that Bluetooth is enabled on your device.
- Try re-pairing the keyboard by holding an Easy-Switch key until it blinks, then re-selecting it in your device's Bluetooth settings.
- Move the keyboard closer to your device to rule out range issues.
- · Restart both the keyboard and your device.

Backlighting Not Working or Dim

- Check the battery level; low battery can disable backlighting.
- Ensure the ambient light sensor is not obstructed.
- Manually adjust the brightness using the F5 (dimmer) and F6 (brighter) keys.

Keys Not Responding

- Ensure the keyboard is connected to the correct device (check Easy-Switch key indicator).
- Clean around the affected keys to remove any debris.
- Restart the keyboard and the connected device.
