SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials, labels, and tags from the slow cooker and its components.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Wash the removable inner pot and glass lid with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Wipe the exterior of the slow cooker base with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the base in water.

1. **Power On:** Plug the slow cooker into a standard electrical outlet. The display will show '00:00'. Press the 'On/Off' button to activate the unit.
2. **Add Ingredients:** Place your ingredients into the removable inner pot.
3. **Select Mode:** Press the 'Mode' button to cycle through the cooking settings: LOW, MED (Medium), and HIGH. The selected mode will illuminate on the display.
4. **Set Cooking Time:** Use the rotary knob to adjust the cooking time. Turn clockwise to increase time and counter-clockwise to decrease. Time can be set from 30 minutes to 20 hours.
5. **Start Cooking:** Once the mode and time are set, the slow cooker will automatically begin cooking after a few seconds.
6. **Delay Timer (Optional):** To delay the start of cooking, press the 'Delay Timer' button. Use the rotary knob to set the delay time (up to 10 hours). After the delay time counts down, the slow cooker will automatically begin cooking with the previously set mode and time.

7. **Keep Warm Function:** After the set cooking time has elapsed, the slow cooker will automatically switch to 'Keep Warm' mode for up to 4 hours. The 'Keep Warm' indicator light will illuminate.
8. **Power Off:** To turn off the slow cooker at any time, press and hold the 'On/Off' button until the display turns off.

- **Stovetop Searing/Sautéing:** The lightweight inner pot can be removed from the base and used directly on your stovetop to sear meats or sauté vegetables before slow cooking. This helps to lock in flavors and create richer dishes.
- **Oven Safe:** The inner pot is also oven-safe up to 350°F, allowing you to finish dishes in the oven or use it for baking.

- **One-Pot Meals:** This multi-use functionality reduces the need for multiple pots and pans, simplifying your cooking process and cleanup.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity and performance of your GreenLife Slow Cooker.

Cleaning

1. **Unplug:** Always unplug the slow cooker from the electrical outlet and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
2. **Removable Pot and Lid:** The removable inner pot and glass lid are dishwasher safe. For hand washing, use warm, soapy water and a non-abrasive sponge or cloth. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
3. **Exterior Base:** Wipe the exterior of the slow cooker base with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as they may damage the finish. Never immerse the base in water or any other liquid.
4. **Stubborn Food Residue:** For stubborn food residue in the inner pot, fill it with warm, soapy water and let it soak for a period before cleaning.

Storage

Ensure all components are clean and dry before storing. Store the slow cooker in a cool, dry place. Do not wrap the cord tightly around the appliance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Slow cooker does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet malfunction; unit not activated.	Ensure unit is properly plugged in. Check power outlet with another appliance. Press 'On/Off' button to activate.
Food is not cooking properly.	Incorrect cooking mode or time set; insufficient liquid.	Verify cooking mode (LOW, MED, HIGH) and time. Ensure adequate liquid is used for slow cooking.
Food sticks to the pot.	Nonstick coating wear; insufficient oil/liquid.	Ensure proper use of nonstick coating (avoid metal utensils). Use a small amount of oil or cooking spray if needed.
Lid does not fit securely.	Food obstruction; lid not properly aligned.	Check for food blocking the lid. Realign the lid carefully onto the pot.
