INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your Armitron Men's Automatic Skeleton Dial Bracelet Watch, model 20/5330. This timepiece features a scratch-resistant mineral crystal lens and an automatic movement, designed for reliable timekeeping and a distinctive aesthetic.

SETUP

Initial Winding

Your automatic watch is powered by the motion of your wrist. If the watch has stopped or is running low on power, it may require an initial manual winding. To do this, gently rotate the crown clockwise approximately 20-30 times until the second hand begins to move consistently. This will build up a power reserve.

Setting the Time

1. Pull the crown out to the furthest position.
2. Rotate the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the hour and minute hands to the correct time.
3. Once the time is set, push the crown back into its original position to start the watch.

Bracelet Adjustment

The silver-tone adjustable link bracelet can be resized for a comfortable fit. It is recommended to have this adjustment performed by a qualified jeweler or watch technician to prevent damage to the links or clasp.

OPERATING YOUR WATCH

Automatic Movement

This watch features an automatic mechanical movement. It does not require a battery. The movement is powered by the natural motion of your arm. When worn regularly, the watch will remain wound. If the watch is not worn for an extended period, it may stop and require manual winding as described in the "Initial Winding" section.

Water Resistance

Your Armitron watch is water resistant to 165 feet (50 meters). This rating indicates that the watch is suitable for short periods of recreational swimming, but it is not designed for diving or snorkeling. Avoid operating the crown or pushers while the watch is wet or submerged to prevent water intrusion.

ACCIDENTAL SPLASHES

WATER RESISTANT TO 30M (100FT):

In general, withstands splashes or brief immersion in water, but not suitable for swimming or bathing



SWIMMING

WATER RESISTANT TO 50M (165FT):

In general, suitable for short periods of recreational swimming, but not diving or snorkeling



SNORKELING

WATER RESISTANT TO 100 M (330 FT):

In general, suitable for swimming and snorkeling, but not scuba diving

MAINTENANCE
