1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Rastar Bugatti Chiron 75700 Radio Controlled Car. This manual provides essential information for the safe operation, setup, and maintenance of your new RC car. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper function and to prevent damage.




Image 1.1: The Rastar Bugatti Chiron Radio Controlled Car with its remote control.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- This product is suitable for users aged 6 years and above. Adult supervision is recommended for younger users.
- Do not operate the RC car in public streets, near people, or in areas with obstacles.
- Keep fingers, hair, and loose clothing away from the wheels and moving parts of the car.

- Do not operate the car in wet conditions or near water to prevent electrical damage.
- Always turn off the car and remote control when not in use.
- Use only the recommended batteries and ensure correct polarity during installation.
- Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.
- Remove exhausted batteries promptly to prevent leakage.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please check the package contents to ensure all items are present:

- Rastar Bugatti Chiron RC Car (1:14 Scale)
- Remote Control Transmitter
- Instruction Manual (this document)

Note: Batteries are not included and must be purchased separately.

4. SETUP

4.1. Battery Installation for the RC Car

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the RC car.
2. Use a screwdriver to open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert the required batteries (typically AA or AAA, refer to packaging for exact type) into the compartment, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Replace the battery compartment cover and secure it with the screw.

4.2. Battery Installation for the Remote Control

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
2. Use a screwdriver to open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert the required batteries (typically AA or AAA, refer to packaging for exact type) into the compartment, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Replace the battery compartment cover and secure it with the screw.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Powering On and Pairing

1. Ensure batteries are correctly installed in both the car and the remote control.
2. Turn on the RC car using the ON/OFF switch, usually located on the underside or side of the car.
3. Turn on the remote control using its ON/OFF switch.
4. The car and remote should automatically pair. If not, turn both off and on again, ensuring they are close to each other.

5.2. Basic Controls




Image 5.1: The remote control for the Rastar Bugatti Chiron.

- **Forward/Backward:** Use the left joystick or trigger (depending on remote design) to move the car forward or backward.
- **Left/Right:** Use the right joystick or steering wheel (depending on remote design) to steer the car left or right.
- Familiarize yourself with the controls in an open, safe area before attempting complex maneuvers.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1. Cleaning

- Wipe the car and remote control with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use chemical cleaners or water, as this can damage electronic components.
- Remove any debris (dust, hair) from the wheels and axles to ensure smooth operation.

6.2. Storage

- Always remove batteries from both the car and the remote control if storing for extended periods.
- Store the RC car and remote in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Keep the product in its original packaging or a protective container to prevent damage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Car does not move or respond.	Low or dead batteries in car or remote. Car/remote not turned on. Car/remote not paired.	Replace batteries. Ensure both car and remote are switched ON. Turn both off and on again to re-pair.
Short control range.	Low batteries in remote. Interference from other electronic devices. Obstacles blocking signal.	Replace remote batteries. Move to an area with less interference. Operate in open spaces.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Car moves slowly or erratically.	Low batteries in car. Debris in wheels.	Replace car batteries. Clean wheels and axles.




Image 8.1: Detailed rear view of the Rastar Bugatti Chiron RC car.
