1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Homdox Rolling Garment Rack B2. This heavy-duty, free-standing wardrobe rack is designed to provide versatile storage solutions for your clothing and accessories. Featuring adjustable wire shelves, double hanging rods, and lockable wheels, it offers robust and flexible organization for various spaces such as bedrooms, laundry rooms, or walk-in closets. Please read this manual carefully before assembly and use to ensure proper installation and safe operation.

2. KEY FEATURES

- **Strong Storage Capacity:** Features 3 tiers of wire shelves and 2 hanging rods, offering diverse storage options. Shelves are adjustable or removable to accommodate different sized items, maximizing space for shoes, hanging garments, and folded clothes.
- **Lockable 360° Wheels:** Equipped with 4 industrial-grade casters, 2 of which are lockable, allowing for easy movement and secure positioning in any desired location.
- **Space-saving Design:** The double rod configuration optimizes vertical space, enabling more clothes to be hung in a compact footprint compared to traditional designs.
- **Maximum Load Capacity:** Constructed from premium thickened carbon steel with a powder-coated finish for rust and water resistance. Each wire shelf supports up to 133 lbs, with a total weight capacity of 450 lbs (evenly distributed). Hanging rods support up to 100 lbs, and side hooks up to 22 lbs.
- **Easy Assembly:** Designed for quick and straightforward assembly, typically taking less than 20 minutes.

5. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of 450 lbs (evenly distributed) to prevent collapse or damage.
- Ensure all connections are securely fastened before placing items on the rack.
- Always lock the wheels when the rack is in a stationary position to prevent unintended movement.
- Keep small parts away from children during assembly to avoid choking hazards.
- Distribute weight evenly across shelves and hanging rods to maintain stability.
- Avoid climbing or hanging on the rack, as this may cause it to tip over.

6. SETUP (ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS)

Follow these steps for quick and easy assembly. It is recommended to have two people for certain steps.

6.1. Unpack and Identify Components

Carefully unpack all parts from the box and lay them out on a clean, flat surface. Refer to the parts list in your included manual to identify each component.

6.2. Attach Wheels

Screw the industrial-grade casters into the bottom of the four vertical poles. Ensure they are tightened securely. Two of the wheels have locking mechanisms for stability.

6.3. Assemble Vertical Poles and Set Shelf Height

Connect the sections of the vertical poles. Use the plastic clips to mark the desired height for each shelf. Ensure the clips are placed at the same height on all four poles for a level shelf.

6.4. Install Wire Shelves

Slide the wire shelves down onto the clips until they are firmly seated. The shelves are designed to fit snugly over the clips, providing a stable surface.

6.5. Attach Hanging Rods and Side Hooks

Secure the double clothes hanging rods between the vertical poles at the desired heights. Attach the side hooks to the outer poles for additional hanging space for bags, belts, or other accessories.

7. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1. Adjusting Shelf Height

To adjust a shelf, remove all items from the shelf. Lift the shelf slightly, remove the plastic clips from the vertical poles, reposition them to the desired height, and then lower the shelf back onto the clips. Ensure all four clips are at the same height for stability.

7.2. Using Lockable Wheels

To move the rack, unlock the two lockable wheels by flipping their levers. Once the rack is in the desired position, lock the wheels again to secure it in place and prevent accidental movement.

7.3. Utilizing Hanging Rods and Side Hooks

Use the double hanging rods for organizing shirts, dresses, pants, and other garments. The side hooks provide convenient access for accessories like handbags, scarves, or belts.

8. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the rack with a soft, damp cloth to remove dust and dirt. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the powder-coated finish.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all connections and fasteners to ensure they remain tight and secure. Tighten any loose parts as needed.
- **Rust Prevention:** The rack features a rust-proof powder-coated finish. To maintain this, avoid prolonged exposure to excessive moisture.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING

9.1. Rack is Wobbly

- Ensure all shelves are properly seated on their clips and that clips are at the same height on all poles.
- Check that all pole sections are fully connected and tightened.
- Verify that weight is evenly distributed across the rack.

9.2. Wheels Not Locking/Moving Smoothly

- Ensure the locking levers on the wheels are fully engaged or disengaged.

- Check for any debris or obstructions around the wheels that might hinder movement.
