#### **NTRODUCTION**

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Cybex Talos S Lux Stroller. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product and retain it for future reference. Proper use and maintenance ensure the longevity and safety of your stroller.

#### IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

### WARNING: Failure to follow these warnings and instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- · Always secure your child with the harness system.
- · Never leave your child unattended in the stroller.
- · Do not use the stroller on stairs or escalators.
- Ensure all locking devices are engaged before use.
- Do not overload the storage basket or attach items to the handle, as this can cause the stroller to become unstable.
- The stroller is designed for children from birth (with compatible accessories like Cot S or infant car seat) up to 55 lbs (approximately 4 years).
- · Always engage the brake when parking the stroller.
- · Keep children clear of moving parts when making adjustments.
- Only use accessories and replacement parts approved by Cybex.

#### SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble your Cybex Talos S Lux Stroller.

#### 1. Unfolding the Stroller

The stroller features a one-hand fold mechanism. To unfold, release the locking latch and lift the handlebar until the frame clicks into place. Ensure all components are securely locked before placing a child in the stroller.

# 2. Attaching the Wheels

The puncture-proof all-terrain wheels are designed for easy attachment. Insert each wheel axle into its corresponding slot on the stroller frame until it clicks securely. Pull on the wheels to ensure they are firmly attached.

# 3. Installing the Seat Unit

Align the seat unit with the connectors on the stroller frame and push down until it locks into place. The seat can be installed in either front-facing or parent-facing positions. Verify that the seat is securely attached by pulling upwards.

# 4. Attaching the Sun Canopy

Attach the sun canopy to the designated points on the seat unit. Ensure it is securely fastened. The canopy is extendable and includes a mesh window for ventilation and observation.

# 5. Harness Adjustment

The stroller features a 5-point harness system with a one-pull harness for easy adjustment. Ensure the harness straps are snug but comfortable around your child.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

# 1. Reclining the Seat

The seat offers multiple recline positions, including a near-flat position suitable for naps. Use the recline lever located at the back of the seat to adjust the angle. Ensure the seat is securely locked in your desired position.

### 2. Adjusting the Handlebar

The leatherette handlebar is adjustable to accommodate users of various heights. Press the buttons on either side of the handlebar and move it to your preferred height, then release to lock.

### 3. Using the Bumper Bar

The leatherette bumper bar can be opened from either side to facilitate placing or removing your child. Press the release button on one side to swing it open.

### 4. Engaging the Brake System

To engage the brake, press down firmly on the brake pedal located near the rear wheels. To release, lift the pedal. Always ensure the brake is fully engaged when the stroller is stationary.

### 5. Utilizing the Shopping Basket

The spacious shopping basket located beneath the seat can hold up to 11 lbs (5 kg) of items. Do not exceed the

# 6. Folding the Stroller

To fold the stroller, ensure the seat is in an upright position. Engage the one-hand fold mechanism (refer to specific instructions in your product guide for exact lever location) and collapse the frame until it locks into a self-standing position.

# 7. 3-in-1 Travel System Compatibility

The Talos S Lux is compatible with Cybex infant car seats and the Cot S (sold separately) to create a versatile travel system. Use the included adapters to securely attach these components to the stroller frame.

### **MAINTENANCE**

- Cleaning Fabric Parts: The fabric parts (Polyester, Polyester and cotton) can be spot cleaned with a mild detergent and cold water. Do not machine wash or tumble dry unless specified on the care label. Allow to air dry completely.
- Cleaning Frame and Plastic Parts: Wipe the frame and plastic components with a damp cloth and mild soap. Dry thoroughly.
- Wheel Maintenance: Regularly check the wheels for debris and remove any obstructions. The puncture-proof wheels require minimal maintenance but ensure they rotate freely.
- Storage: Store the stroller in a dry, well-ventilated area away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically inspect all rivets, screws, and locking mechanisms to ensure they are secure and in good working order. Replace any worn or damaged parts immediately.

#### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stroller does not fold or unfold smoothly.	Locking mechanism engaged; debris in hinges; seat not in correct position.	Ensure all locks are disengaged. Clear any obstructions from hinges. Verify seat is upright before folding. Refer to "Folding the Stroller" section.
Wheels squeak or do not turn freely.	Debris in wheel axles; lack of lubrication.	Remove any hair or dirt from the wheel axles. Apply a silicone- based lubricant to the moving parts of the wheels.
Harness is difficult to adjust.	Straps twisted or caught; buckle mechanism obstructed.	Untwist straps and ensure they are flat. Check the buckle for any obstructions. The one-pull harness should adjust smoothly.
Brake is not engaging or releasing properly.	Debris in brake mechanism; cable adjustment needed.	Clear any debris from the brake pedal and mechanism. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
