1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the correct installation, safe use, and maintenance of your Indesit IWC 7105 C ECO-KSA-XWA 71251 W 60HZ Front Load Washing Machine. Please read these instructions carefully before using the appliance and keep them for future reference. Proper use of the appliance ensures optimal performance and extends its lifespan.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons.

- Ensure the appliance is properly grounded.
- Do not allow children to play on or in the appliance.
- Do not operate the washing machine if it is damaged or malfunctioning.
- Unplug the appliance before performing any maintenance or cleaning.
- Do not wash items that have been previously cleaned in, washed with, soaked in, or spotted with gasoline, dry-cleaning solvents, or other flammable or explosive substances.
- Keep flammable materials and vapors away from the appliance.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your Indesit washing machine.

Control Panel Features:

- **Program Selector Knob:** Used to select one of the 16 available washing programs.
- Start/Pause Button: Initiates or temporarily stops a selected washing cycle.
- LED Display: Shows program status, remaining time, and selected options.
- Detergent Dispenser Drawer: Compartments for pre-wash, main wash detergent, and fabric softener.
- "Push & Wash" Button: A quick start function for a common wash cycle.

4. INSTALLATION AND SETUP

Proper installation is crucial for the washing machine's performance and safety.

- 1. **Unpacking:** Remove all packaging materials and transport bolts from the rear of the machine. Keep packaging for potential future transport.
- 2. **Positioning:** Place the machine on a flat, stable surface. Ensure there is adequate space around the appliance for ventilation and access.

- 3. **Leveling:** Adjust the machine's feet to ensure it is perfectly level. This prevents excessive vibration and noise during operation.
- 4. **Water Connection:** Connect the water inlet hose to a cold water tap. Ensure connections are tight to prevent leaks.
- 5. **Drain Connection:** Securely place the drain hose into a standpipe or connect it to a sink trap, ensuring it is not kinked.
- 6. **Electrical Connection:** Plug the power cord into a grounded 220V electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords or adapters.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for a typical wash cycle:

- 1. **Load Laundry:** Open the door and load laundry into the drum. Do not overload the machine; refer to the capacity guidelines (7 kg).
- 2. **Add Detergent:** Pull out the detergent dispenser drawer and add the appropriate amount of detergent and fabric softener to their respective compartments.
- 3. **Select Program:** Turn the Program Selector Knob to choose the desired washing program based on fabric type and soil level.
- 4. **Select Options (Optional):** If available, select additional options such as extra rinse, spin speed, or temperature using the corresponding buttons.
- 5. Start Cycle: Press the Start/Pause button to begin the wash cycle. The indicator light will illuminate.
- 6. **End of Cycle:** Once the cycle is complete, the machine will signal, and the door lock will release. Remove laundry promptly.

Using the "Push & Wash" Function:

For a quick and convenient wash, simply load your laundry, add detergent, and press the "Push & Wash" button. The machine will automatically select a suitable program for mixed daily laundry.

6. WASHING PROGRAMS

Your Indesit washing machine offers 16 programmed cycles designed for various fabric types and washing needs. Refer to the program selector knob and the appliance's display for specific program details.

- Standard Programs: Typically include Cotton, Synthetics, Mixed, and Delicates.
- Special Programs: May include Wool, Sport, Duvet, or specific stain removal cycles.
- Eco & Rapid Programs: Designed for energy efficiency or quick washing of lightly soiled items. Examples include Eco Cotton, Rapid 30', or Quick Wash.
- Rinse & Spin: Separate cycles for rinsing and spinning only.

Always check garment care labels for recommended washing temperatures and cycles.

7. Maintenance and Cleaning

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your washing machine.

- Cleaning the Detergent Dispenser: Remove and rinse the dispenser drawer regularly to prevent detergent buildup.
- Cleaning the Drum: Run a maintenance wash (e.g., a hot cycle with no laundry and a descaling agent) periodically to clean the drum and remove odors.
- Cleaning the Filter: Locate and clean the drain pump filter every few months to remove lint and small

objects. Refer to the appliance diagram for filter location.

- Cleaning the Exterior: Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- **Door Seal:** Wipe the rubber door seal after each wash to prevent mold and mildew buildup. Leave the door slightly ajar when not in use to allow air circulation.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer service, try these solutions for common issues:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine does not start	No power; door not closed; Start/Pause not pressed.	Check power supply; ensure door is latched; press Start/Pause.
Water not filling	Water tap closed; inlet hose kinked; water pressure low.	Open water tap; straighten hose; check household water supply.
Water not draining	Drain hose kinked; drain filter blocked; pump malfunction.	Straighten drain hose; clean drain filter; contact service if pump issue persists.
Excessive vibration/noise	Machine not level; transport bolts not removed; unbalanced load.	Adjust leveling feet; ensure transport bolts are removed; redistribute laundry in drum.
