SETUP

- 2. **Positioning:** Place the heater on a firm, level surface. Ensure it is at least 3 feet (0.9 meters) away from walls, furniture, curtains, or other flammable materials. Do not place it on carpets with long piles.
- 3. **Power Connection:** Ensure the heater is switched off. Plug the power cord directly into a 120V AC, 60Hz grounded wall outlet. Do not use extension cords, power strips, or surge protectors.
- 4. **Remote Control Batteries:** If using the remote control, insert the required batteries (not included) into the remote control unit.

Control Panel and Display:

- Power Button (): Turns the heater On or Off.
- Mode Button (M): Cycles through heat settings (Low, Medium, High).
- Temperature Up (▲) / Down (▼) Buttons: Adjusts the desired temperature.
- Timer Button (): Sets the operating timer.
- ECO Mode Button (): Activates energy-saving mode.

- 5. **Timer Function:** Press the Timer button to set an auto-off timer. Each press typically increases the timer by one hour. Refer to the display for the set duration.
- 6. **Turning Off:** Press the Power button again. The heater will stop operating. Unplug the unit from the wall outlet when not in use for extended periods.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and efficient operation of your Senville heater. Always unplug the heater

and allow it to cool completely before performing any maintenance.

• Cleaning:

- Wipe the exterior surfaces of the heater with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Ensure no water enters the interior of the heater.
- Do not immerse the heater in water.

• Storage:

- If storing the heater for an extended period, clean it thoroughly.
- Store the heater in a cool, dry place, preferably in its original packaging, to protect it from dust and damage.
- Wrap the power cord neatly to prevent tangling or damage.
- **No User-Serviceable Parts:** This heater contains no user-serviceable parts. Do not attempt to open or repair the unit yourself. Any repairs should be performed by qualified service personnel.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your Senville heater, please consult the following common problems and solutions before contacting customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Heater does not turn on.	Not plugged in securely. No power to the outlet. Overheat protection activated. Tip-over switch activated.	Ensure the power cord is firmly plugged into a grounded outlet. Check the circuit breaker or try a different outlet. Unplug the heater, wait 30 minutes for it to cool down, then plug it back in. Ensure the heater is on a flat, stable surface and upright.
Heater produces no heat or insufficient heat.	Temperature setting too low. Heat mode not selected. Room size too large for heater.	Increase the desired temperature setting. Press the Mode button to select a higher heat setting (Medium or High). Ensure the heater is appropriately sized for the room.
Heater makes unusual noises.	Normal expansion/contraction of metal. Loose part (unlikely for oil-filled).	Minor clicking or crackling sounds are normal as the oil heats and cools. If noises are loud or persistent, unplug the unit and contact customer support.


