INTRODUCTION

The Shure SE846 Wired Sound Isolating Earbuds are engineered to deliver high-definition audio with natural bass. Featuring four custom-engineered drivers, these earbuds provide extended high-end clarity and robust low-end performance. The secure in-ear fit and sound isolating technology block external noise, ensuring an immersive listening experience. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your SE846 earbuds.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Your Shure SE846 package includes the following components:

- SE846 Detachable Sound Isolating Earphones
- 3.5 mm communication cable with integrated remote + mic
- Fit kit with a variety of ear tips (silicone and foam sleeves in various sizes)
- 1/4" adapter
- Hard carrying case
- Cleaning tool

SETUP

1. Selecting the Right Ear Tips

Proper ear tip selection is crucial for optimal sound isolation and comfort. Experiment with the various sizes and materials (foam or silicone) provided in the fit kit to find the best seal for your ears. A good seal enhances bass response and blocks external noise effectively.

2. Attaching the Cable

The SE846 earbuds feature a detachable 3.5 mm communication cable with MMCX connectors. To attach the cable, align the connector on the cable with the receptacle on the earbud. Push firmly until you hear a click. To detach, gently pull the cable straight out from the earbud without twisting.

3. Wearing the Earbuds

The SE846 earbuds are designed for an over-the-ear fit to ensure comfort and stability. The cable should loop over the top of your ear and then run down your back or front, depending on preference. This design helps keep the cables out of the way during activity and reduces microphonics (cable noise).

4. Customizable Frequency Response

The SE846 allows you to customize the frequency response to your preference. This is achieved through removable nozzles that offer balanced, warm, or bright audio signatures. Refer to the included documentation for detailed instructions on how to change these nozzles.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Connecting to Devices

Connect the 3.5 mm jack of the communication cable to your audio source (e.g., smartphone, tablet, laptop, in-flight entertainment system). The cable is compatible with Apple and Android devices.

2. Using the Integrated Remote + Mic

The integrated remote and microphone provide seamless control for phone calls, voice commands, volume adjustment, and music playback. Refer to your device's manual for specific button functions.

3. Sound Isolation

The Sound Isolating technology blocks up to 37 dB of ambient noise. This passive noise reduction allows you to enjoy your audio without distractions, making it ideal for travel, exercise, or noisy environments.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning Your Earbuds

Regular cleaning helps maintain sound quality and hygiene. Use the provided cleaning tool to remove any earwax or debris from the ear tips and nozzle. Gently wipe the earbuds and cable with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or excessive moisture.

2. Cable Care

The detachable cable is designed for durability. To prolong its life, avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling. When not in use, store the earbuds and cable neatly in the hard carrying case to prevent tangling and damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your SE846 earbuds, consider the following general troubleshooting steps:

- **No Sound or Low Volume:** Ensure the 3.5 mm cable is securely connected to both the earbuds and the audio source. Check the volume levels on your device. Verify that the correct ear tips are used to achieve a proper seal.
- **Distorted Sound:** Check for debris in the earbud nozzles and clean them if necessary. Test with a different audio source or cable to rule out external issues.

- **Intermittent Connection:** Ensure the MMCX connectors are firmly attached. If the issue persists, the cable may need replacement.
- **Discomfort:** Experiment with different ear tip sizes and materials to find the most comfortable fit. Ensure the over-the-ear cable is positioned correctly.
