1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your BOOX Nova Air 7.8" Paper Tablet. This device is designed to provide a comfortable and versatile e-reading and note-taking experience with its E Ink display and Android operating system. This manual will guide you through the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your device, ensuring you get the most out of its features.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon unboxing your BOOX Nova Air, please ensure all the following items are present:

- BOOX Pen (Stylus pen)
- USB-C cable
- Quick Start Guide
- Warranty card

3. SETUP

3.1 Initial Setup

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge your Nova Air using the provided USB-C cable. Connect the cable to the device's USB-C port and a compatible power adapter (not included) or computer USB port.

To power on the device, press and hold the power button located on the side until the BOOX logo appears. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your preferred language, connect to a Wi-Fi network, and complete the initial setup process.

3.2 Connecting to Wi-Fi

To connect to a Wi-Fi network:

1. Go to **Settings**.
2. Select **Network & Internet**.
3. Tap **Wi-Fi** and turn it on.
4. Select your desired network from the list and enter the password if prompted.

3.3 System Updates

For optimal performance and access to the latest features, regularly check for and install firmware updates. You can do this by navigating to **Settings > Firmware Update**. Keeping your device updated ensures better handwriting experience and system stability.

4. OPERATING YOUR NOVA AIR

4.1 Navigating the Interface

The Nova Air features a responsive touch screen and a physical power button. You can navigate the interface using touch gestures similar to other Android devices. The power button can also be configured for various functions.

4.2 Reading Documents

The Nova Air supports a wide range of document formats, including PDF (reflowable), PPT, EPUB, TXT, DJVU, HTML, RTF, FB2, DOC, MOBI, and CHM. Its 7.8" HD E Ink screen with 300 dpi resolution ensures sharp text and clear images, reducing eye strain.

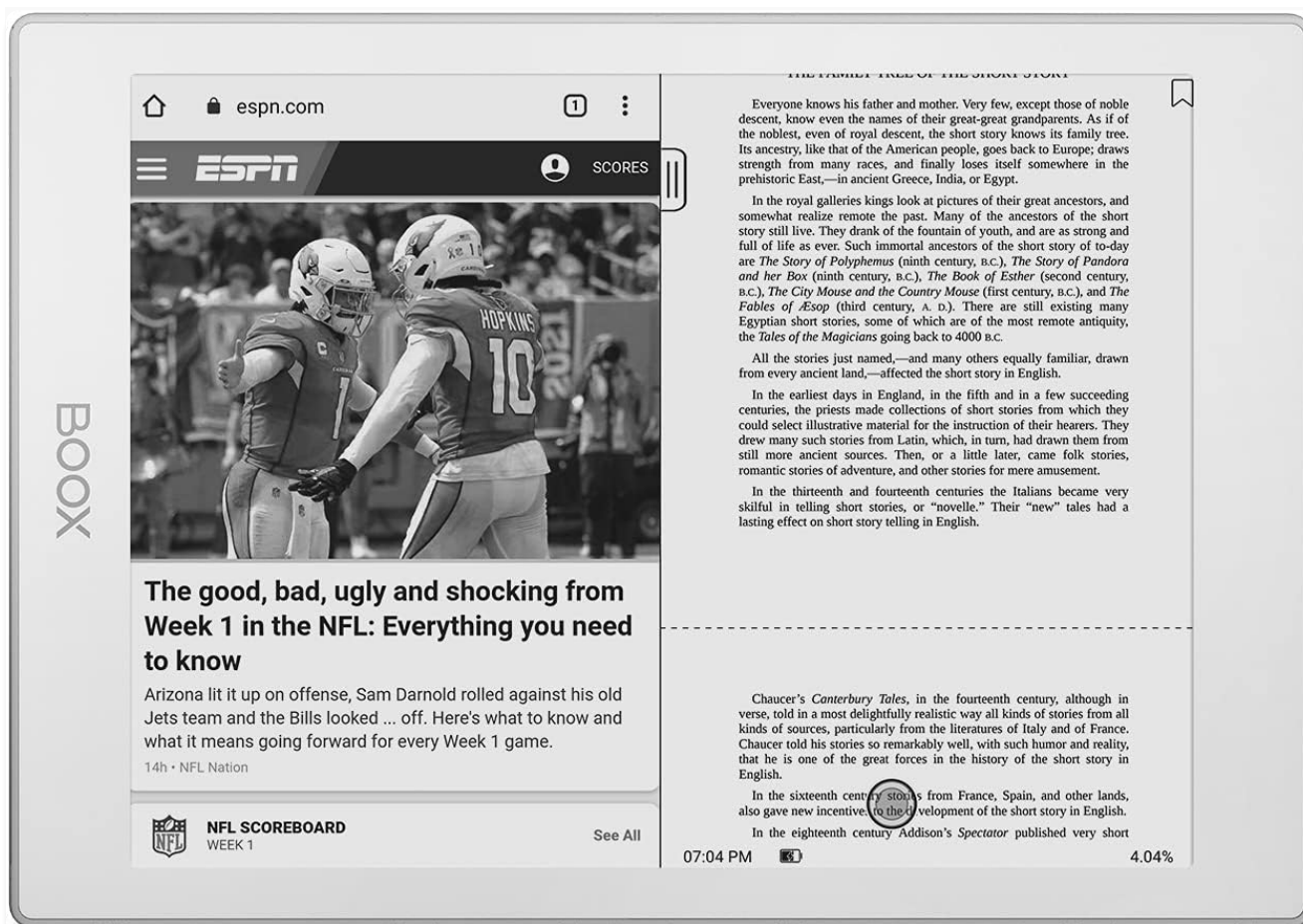


Image: Browsing a web page on the Nova Air.

4.4 File Management and Transfer

The Nova Air comes with 32GB of internal storage for your documents, notes, and applications. You can transfer files via USB-C (supporting OTG) or through Wi-Fi synchronization services.

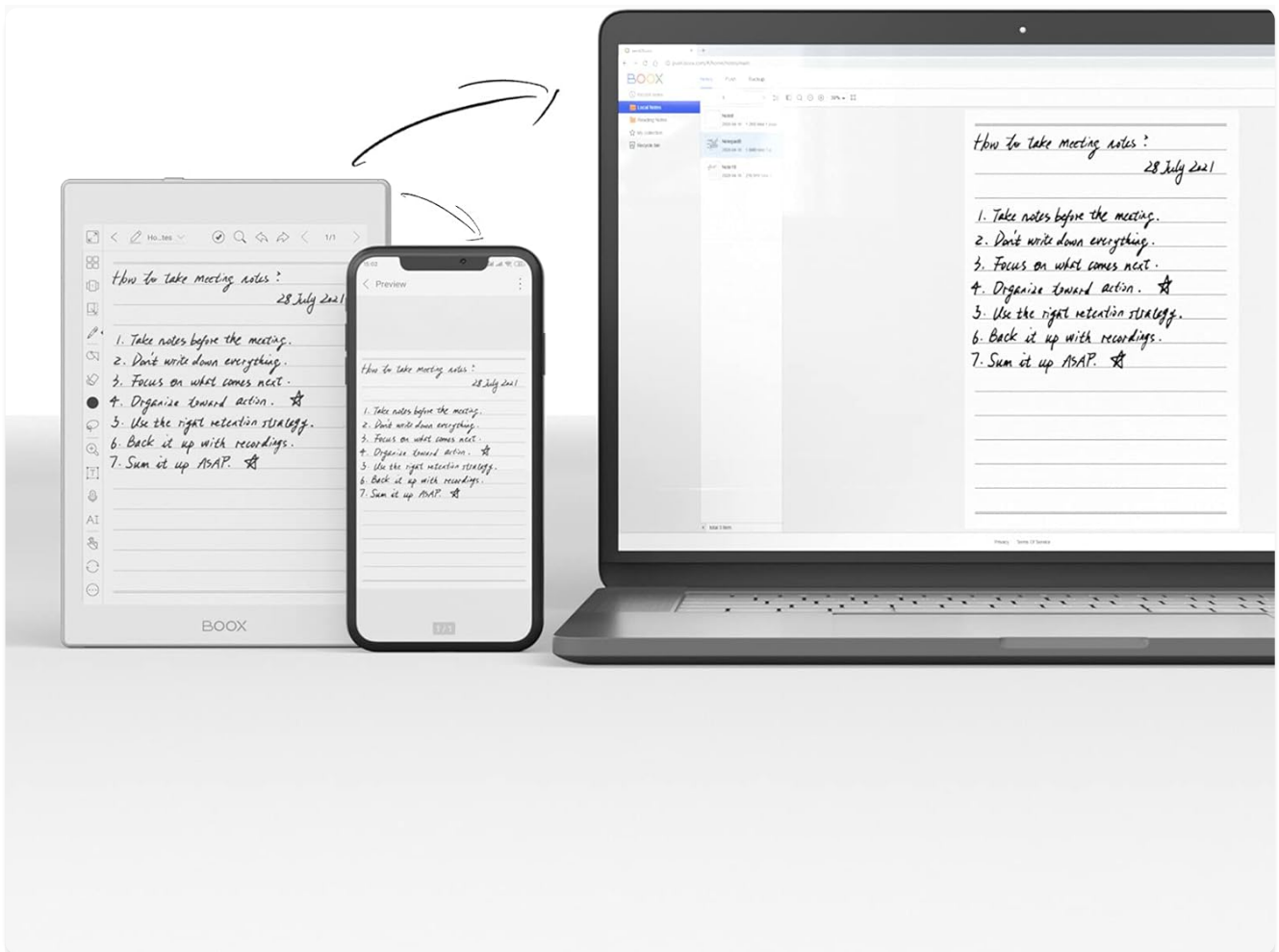


Image: Seamless synchronization of notes across devices.

4.5 App Installation

Running on Android 10.0, the Nova Air allows you to install various applications from the BOOX Store or other third-party app stores. This expands the functionality beyond standard e-reading, enabling access to cloud storage, news apps, and more.

4.6 Audio Features

The device includes built-in dual speakers and a microphone. An earphone jack is available via the USB-C port, allowing you to listen to audiobooks or other audio content.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

To clean the screen and body of your Nova Air, use a soft, lint-free cloth. For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

5.2 Battery Care

The Nova Air is equipped with a 2000mAh Polymer Li-ion battery, offering up to 26 days of standby time. To prolong battery life, avoid extreme temperatures and fully discharging the device regularly. Charge the device when the battery level is low.

5.3 Storage Management

Periodically review your stored files and applications to manage the 32GB internal memory. Delete unnecessary files or transfer them to cloud storage or a computer to free up space and maintain optimal performance.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your BOOX Nova Air, please refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **Device not turning on:** Ensure the device is charged. Connect it to a power source and try powering it on again.
- **Screen not responding:** Perform a soft reset by holding the power button for 10-15 seconds until the device restarts.
- **Wi-Fi connectivity issues:** Check your Wi-Fi router and ensure it's working correctly. Try forgetting the network on your Nova Air and reconnecting.
- **Stylus not responding:** Ensure the stylus tip is clean and not damaged. If the issue persists, try restarting the device.
- **Applications crashing:** Try clearing the cache of the problematic app or reinstalling it. Ensure your device firmware is up to date.
