1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Belva BVL62 Double DIN CD/DVD Bluetooth Car Stereo. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper function and to prevent damage. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always operate the vehicle safely. Do not perform any operations that distract you from driving.
- Ensure proper wiring connections to prevent electrical shorts or damage to the unit or vehicle.
- Do not disassemble or modify the unit. This may cause malfunction or injury.
- Avoid exposing the unit to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight for prolonged periods, or excessive moisture.
- Consult a professional for installation if you are unsure about any steps.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

4.1 Front Panel

The rear panel provides various connections for power, speakers, external devices, and cameras:

- Wiring Harness Connector: Connects to the vehicle's power, ground, and speaker wires.
- **Preamp Outputs (RCA):** Front (FL/FR), Rear (RL/RR), and Subwoofer (SUB) outputs for connecting external amplifiers.
- Camera Inputs (RCA): Dedicated inputs for Front Camera (F-CAM), Rearview Camera (CAM), and Video Input (V-IN).
- Video Outputs (RCA): V1 and V2 for connecting external monitors.
- Antenna Input: For connecting the vehicle's radio antenna.

5. Installation

Proper installation is crucial for the performance and longevity of your car stereo. If you are not confident in performing the installation yourself, it is recommended to seek professional assistance.

5.1 Mounting the Unit

- 1. Remove the existing car stereo from your vehicle.
- 2. Attach the supplied mounting brackets to the sides of the BVL62 unit using the provided screws. Ensure the brackets are securely fastened.
- 3. Slide the unit into the Double DIN opening in your vehicle's dashboard.
- 4. Secure the unit by fastening the brackets to the vehicle's mounting points.

5.2 Wiring Connections

Refer to the wiring diagram provided with your unit for specific connections. General wiring includes:

- Power: Connect the yellow wire (constant 12V), red wire (accessory 12V), and black wire (ground).
- **Speakers:** Connect the speaker wires (e.g., white/white-black for front left, gray/gray-black for front right, green/green-black for rear left, purple/purple-black for rear right) to your vehicle's speakers.
- Antenna: Connect the vehicle's radio antenna cable.
- Remote Turn-On: Blue wire for external amplifier or power antenna.
- **Reverse Gear Signal:** Connect to the vehicle's reverse light circuit for automatic rearview camera activation.

6. BASIC OPERATION

6.1 Power On/Off

Press the power button on the front panel to turn the unit on. Press and hold the power button to turn the unit off

6.2 Volume Adjustment

Use the volume up/down buttons on the front panel or the remote control to adjust the audio level.

6.3 Source Selection

From the main menu on the touchscreen, tap the desired icon (e.g., Radio, Disc, USB, Bluetooth, Aux In) to select the audio/video source.

7. BLUETOOTH OPERATION

The BVL62 supports Bluetooth for hands-free calling and audio streaming.

7.1 Pairing a Device

- 1. Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your mobile device.
- 2. On the BVL62, select the 'Bluetooth' icon from the main menu.
- Search for available devices on your mobile phone. The unit will appear as 'BELVA BVL62'.
- 4. Select 'BELVA BVL62' on your phone to pair. If prompted, enter the PIN '0000'.

7.2 Hands-Free Calling

Once paired, you can make and receive calls directly through the BVL62. Use the touchscreen interface to dial numbers, answer, or end calls. The external microphone ensures clear voice transmission.

7.3 Bluetooth Audio Streaming (A2DP)

After pairing, you can stream audio from your mobile device to the BVL62. Select the 'Bluetooth Audio' option on the unit and control playback (play/pause, skip tracks) from either your phone or the stereo's touchscreen.

8. PHONE MIRRORING FOR ANDROID DEVICES

The BVL62 supports phone mirroring, allowing you to display and control your Android smartphone's screen on the stereo's display.

- 1. Connect your Android smartphone to the BVL62 via a USB cable.
- 2. Select the 'Phonelink' icon from the main menu on the BVL62.
- 3. Follow the on-screen prompts on both the stereo and your phone to establish the connection. This may require installing a specific app on your Android device.
- 4. Once connected, your phone's screen will be mirrored on the BVL62 display, allowing touch control of your phone's applications.

9. MEDIA PLAYBACK

9.1 CD/DVD Playback

1. Insert a CD or DVD into the disc slot. The unit will automatically switch to Disc mode.

2. Use the on-screen controls for playback functions such as play, pause, skip, fast forward, and rewind.

9.2 USB/SD Playback

- 1. Insert a USB drive into the front USB port or an SD card into the SD card slot.
- 2. Select 'USB' or 'SDHC' from the main menu.
- 3. Browse files and folders on the touchscreen to select your desired audio or video content.

10. RADIO OPERATION

- 1. Select the 'Radio' icon from the main menu.
- 2. **Band Selection:** Tap to switch between FM and AM bands.
- 3. **Tuning:** Use the 'Seek' buttons to automatically scan for the next strong station. Manual tuning may also be available.
- 4. **Preset Stations:** Touch and hold a numbered preset button on the screen to save the current station. Tap to recall a saved station.

11. CAMERA INPUTS

The BVL62 features dedicated inputs for rearview and dash cameras.

- **Rearview Camera:** Connect a rearview camera to the 'CAM' RCA input. When the vehicle is shifted into reverse, the display will automatically switch to the rearview camera feed.
- Front Camera/Dashcam: Connect a front camera or dashcam to the 'F-CAM' input. This can be

12. AUDIO SETTINGS

Access the 'Settings' menu and navigate to 'Sound' or 'Audio' to adjust various sound parameters:

- **Equalizer:** Adjust frequency bands to customize the sound profile (e.g., Pop, Rock, Jazz, or custom settings).
- Fader/Balance: Adjust the sound distribution between front/rear and left/right speakers.
- **Subwoofer Control:** If a subwoofer is connected to the preamp output, you can adjust its level independently.
- Loudness: Boosts bass and treble frequencies at low volume levels.

13. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning the Screen: Use a soft, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the touchscreen. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Cleaning the Unit: Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, dry cloth.
- Disc Slot: Keep the disc slot free of dust and debris. Do not insert foreign objects.

14. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your BVL62 unit, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution		
Unit does not power on.	Incorrect wiring; Blown fuse; Vehicle battery issue.	Check power and ground connections. Inspect vehicle fuses. Ensure vehicle battery is charged.		
No sound.	Volume too low; Mute activated; Incorrect speaker wiring; Amplifier issue.	Increase volume. Check mute status. Verify speaker connections. Check external amplifier if used.		
Bluetooth not connecting.	Bluetooth not enabled on phone; Incorrect pairing process; Interference.	Ensure phone's Bluetooth is on. Re-attempt pairing process. Move closer to the unit.		
Disc playback issues.	Dirty or scratched disc; Incorrect disc format; Unit malfunction.	Clean disc. Try a different disc. Ensure disc format is supported (CD, DVD). If persistent, contact support.		
Unit randomly shuts down.	Loose power connection; Overheating; Internal electrical issue.	Check all power connections. Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit. If issue persists, a reset or professional inspection may be required.
