INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Emerio AF-121914 XXL Hot Air Fryer. This appliance is designed to prepare a wide variety of dishes using hot air circulation, offering a healthier alternative to traditional frying with little to no oil. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use to ensure safe and optimal operation.

This 13-liter multi-oven features an 1800W heating element, a digital display, and various accessories to enhance your cooking experience. It is also BPA-free.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the main components and included accessories of your Emerio Hot Air Fryer.

Main Unit Features:

- **Digital Control Panel:** Intuitive touch controls and LED display for temperature and time.

- **Large Capacity:** 13-liter cooking chamber, suitable for family-sized meals.
- **Transparent Viewing Window:** Monitor cooking progress without opening the door.
- **Internal Lighting:** Illuminates the cooking chamber for better visibility.
- **Air Outlet Vent:** Located at the rear for proper air circulation.

- **Rotisserie Handle:** For safe removal of the rotisserie spit.



SETUP AND FIRST USE

Unpacking:

1. Carefully remove the appliance and all accessories from the packaging.
2. Remove any packaging materials, stickers, or labels.
3. Inspect the appliance for any damage. Do not use if damaged.

Placement:

- Place the air fryer on a stable, heat-resistant, and level surface.
- Ensure there is sufficient space (at least 10 cm) around the appliance for proper ventilation, especially at the rear air outlet.
- Do not place the appliance near flammable materials or heat sources.

Cleaning Before First Use:

1. Wash all removable accessories (rotating basket, skewers, rotisserie spit, baking plate, drying racks) with warm soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
2. Wipe the interior and exterior of the main unit with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the main unit in water.

Initial Burn-in (Optional but Recommended):

For the first use, it is recommended to run the air fryer empty for about 10-15 minutes at 180°C (356°F) to burn off any manufacturing residues. A slight odor or smoke may be present during this process; this is normal. Ensure good ventilation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Emerio AF-121914 features an intuitive digital control panel for easy operation.

Basic Operation:

- 1. Power On:** Plug the appliance into a grounded electrical outlet. The display will light up.
- 2. Select Function:** Use the touch icons on the control panel to select a preset cooking function (e.g., fries, chicken, fish).
- 3. Adjust Temperature and Time:**
 - The appliance features a continuously adjustable thermostat, allowing you to set the temperature up to 200°C (392°F).
 - Use the central dial or dedicated buttons to adjust the temperature and cooking time.
 - The LED display will show the current temperature and remaining time.
- 4. Start Cooking:** Press the Start/Pause button to begin the cooking cycle.
- 5. Monitoring:** The transparent viewing window allows you to monitor food without opening the door.
- 6. Completion:** Once the timer reaches zero, the appliance will emit an audible signal.

Using Accessories:

- **Rotating Basket:** Place food inside the basket, secure the lid, and insert it into the rotisserie slots inside the oven. Select the rotisserie function if available.
- **Rotisserie Spit:** Skewer a whole chicken or roast onto the spit, secure with forks, and insert into the rotisserie slots. Use the rotisserie function.
- **Drying Racks:** Place food evenly on the racks and slide them into the oven slots. Use the dehydration function for best results.
- **Baking Plate:** Use this at the bottom to catch any drips or for baking smaller items.

Always ensure accessories are properly secured before starting the cooking process.

COOKING GUIDE AND TIPS

The Emerio Hot Air Fryer cooks food by circulating hot air, similar to a convection oven. This method ensures even cooking and crispy results without excessive oil.

General Tips:

- **Preheating:** For best results, preheat the air fryer for 3-5 minutes at the desired cooking temperature before adding food.
- **Oil Usage:** While not always necessary, a small amount of oil (1-2 tablespoons) can enhance crispiness for some foods, especially fresh vegetables or homemade fries.
- **Shake/Flip:** For even cooking, especially with smaller items like fries or nuggets, shake the rotating basket or flip items on racks halfway through the cooking time.
- **Do Not Overfill:** Avoid overcrowding the cooking chamber. Cook in batches if necessary to ensure proper air circulation and even cooking.
- **Food Size:** Cut food into uniform sizes for consistent cooking.
- **Dehydration:** The dehydration function allows you to dry fruits, vegetables, and make jerky. Refer to specific recipes for dehydration times and temperatures.

Example Foods:

- **Fries:** Achieve crispy fries without deep-frying. Use the rotating basket for best results.
- **Nuggets & Schnitzel:** Cook frozen or fresh breaded items to a golden crisp.
- **Chicken:** Roast a whole chicken using the rotisserie spit for tender, juicy results.
- **Fish Sticks:** Cook quickly and evenly.
- **Dehydrated Fruits:** Make healthy snacks like apple chips or dried mango.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your air fryer.

Before Cleaning:

- Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet and allow it to cool down completely before cleaning.

Cleaning the Main Unit:

- Wipe the exterior with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- Clean the interior with a damp cloth. For stubborn food residues, use a non-abrasive sponge and warm soapy water.
- Never immerse the main unit, power cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.

Cleaning Accessories:

- All removable accessories (rotating basket, skewers, rotisserie spit, baking plate, drying racks) are dishwasher safe or can be washed by hand with warm soapy water.
- Ensure all parts are thoroughly dried before reassembling or storing.

Storage:

Store the appliance in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and out of reach of children.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer support, please refer to the following common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet malfunction; appliance not properly closed.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check if the door is fully closed.
Food is not cooked evenly.	Overcrowding; insufficient shaking/flipping; incorrect temperature/time.	Cook in smaller batches. Shake or flip food halfway through. Adjust temperature and time as needed.
White smoke coming from the appliance.	Grease residue from previous use; high-fat food cooking.	Clean the appliance thoroughly after each use. For high-fat foods, place a small amount of water in the drip tray to reduce smoke.
Food is not crispy.	Too much moisture; overcrowding; not enough oil (for some foods).	Pat food dry before cooking. Do not overcrowd. Lightly coat with oil if desired. Increase cooking time or temperature slightly.
