# Cidava OE Integrated Vehicle CD Player Instruction Manual

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Cidava OE Integrated Vehicle CD Player. This device allows you to play your favorite music CDs through your vehicle's factory radio or aftermarket Android navigation system via a USB connection. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper functionality and longevity of the product.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not install the unit upside down or past a zero-degree vertical angle. Incorrect mounting can affect performance and disc playback.
- Ensure the unit is securely mounted to prevent movement during vehicle operation.

- Avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight for prolonged periods, or high humidity.
- Keep the device away from water or other liquids.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or modify the unit. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.

## INSTALLATION

---

The Cidava CD Player is designed for simple plug-and-play installation. Follow these steps for optimal setup:

1. **Check Vehicle Compatibility:** Before installation, verify that your vehicle's factory radio supports USB flash drive functionality and can play WMA or WAV file formats from a disc. This CD player is compatible with vehicles that have a USB port on their factory radio or an aftermarket Android navigation system with a USB interface.
2. **Connect the USB Cable:** Plug the provided USB cable into the USB port on the CD player and then into an available USB port on your vehicle's factory radio or aftermarket head unit.
3. **Mounting Position:** The unit can be mounted either vertically or horizontally. Choose a stable location within your vehicle, such as a glove compartment, center console, or dashboard, where it will not obstruct driving or safety features. Ensure the disc slot is easily accessible.
4. **Avoid Incorrect Mounting:** Do not install the unit upside down or at an angle less than 0 degrees (where the disc label faces downward). Mounting on its side is also not recommended. Refer to the diagram below for correct and incorrect positioning.
5. **Initial Indexing:** After connecting and inserting a CD, allow the unit 10-20 seconds per CD to complete its indexing process. This is crucial for proper installation and to avoid setup issues.

## OPERATION

### Basic CD Playback

- Insert a compatible audio CD into the disc slot. The player will automatically begin indexing the disc.
- Once indexed, the audio from the CD will be routed through your vehicle's sound system via the USB connection.
- Use your vehicle's radio controls (e.g., steering wheel controls, touchscreen interface) to manage playback, including changing tracks, adjusting volume, and pausing/playing.

### Compatible Formats

The Cidava CD Player supports audio CDs in **WMA** or **WAV** formats. **MP3 format is not supported** for direct playback from discs. Ensure your CDs are in one of the supported formats for proper operation.

## MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning and Care

- To clean the exterior of the unit, use a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or chemical sprays.
- Keep the disc slot free from dust and debris. Avoid inserting foreign objects into the slot.
- Handle CDs by their edges to prevent fingerprints and scratches, which can affect playback quality.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
CD player does not power on.	Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the CD player and the vehicle's USB port. Verify that the vehicle's USB port is active.

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
CD does not play or is not recognized.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check if the CD is inserted correctly.</li> <li>• Verify the CD format is WMA or WAV. MP3 discs are not supported.</li> <li>• Allow 10-20 seconds for the unit to index the CD after insertion.</li> <li>• Ensure the CD is clean and free from scratches or damage.</li> <li>• Confirm your factory car radio supports USB flash drive functionality and can play the disc's file formats.</li> </ul>
Skipping or intermittent playback.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check the CD for scratches or dirt.</li> <li>• Ensure the CD player is mounted stably and not subject to excessive vibration.</li> <li>• Verify the USB connection is secure.</li> </ul>
No sound output.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check the volume level on your vehicle's audio system.</li> <li>• Ensure the vehicle's audio input is set to the correct USB source.</li> <li>• Confirm the CD is playing and not paused.</li> </ul>
Unit does not respond to vehicle controls.	Ensure the unit has completed indexing the CD. Some vehicle systems may require a brief period to fully recognize the device.

**Instructions:**

**1. Car host without video playback function:**

- Connect the product to the USB signal interface on the car, and then insert the CD.
- Enter the main interface of the car host, click the music icon, and then select the USB flash disk.
- At this time, the tracks in the CD can be seen on the screen of the car host.
- Press the play button, and the control buttons on the interface can control the sound addition and subtraction, stop and other tracks.

**2. Car host with video playback function:**

- Connect the product to the USB signal interface on the car and then put in the CD.
- Enter the main interface of the car host, click the "Video" icon, and then select the USB flash disk.
- At this time, you can see the video tracks in the DVD.
- You can click any track to play, and the control buttons on the interface can control the sound addition and subtraction, stop and other tracks.

**3. Faults and detection:**

- If the CD cannot be read, the car host is not compatible with WAV music format. At this time, we need to use the audio decoder that is purchased separately.
- If the CD can be read but the DVD cannot, the car host is not compatible with the USB format video file.
- How to test the performance of the product? Connect the product to the USB port of the PC computer and insert the CD. If the CD file can be read, it indicates that the performance of the product is normal.
