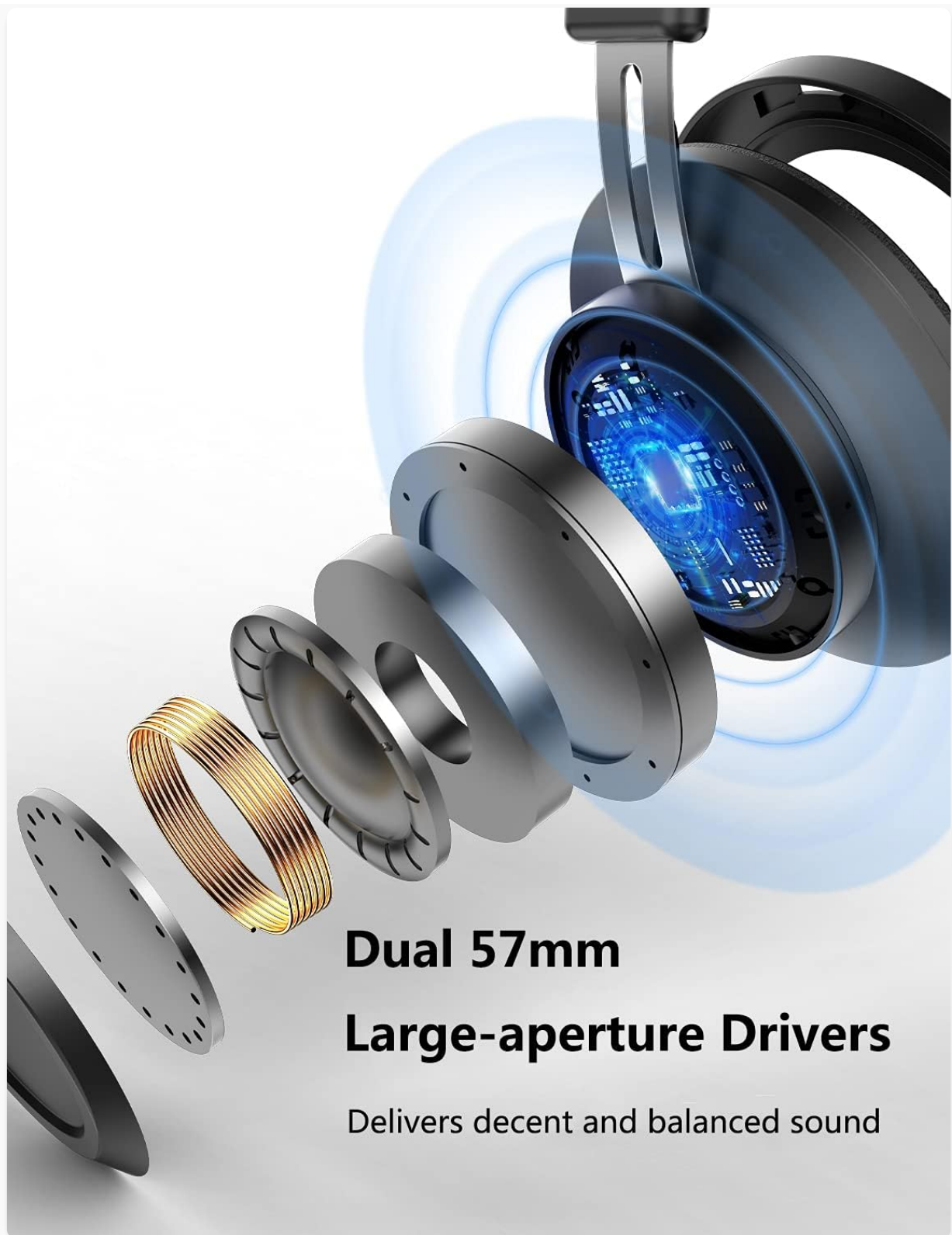

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The Bluedio BT5 headphones are designed for comfort and high-quality audio, featuring dual 57mm large aperture drivers for impressive stereo sound and Bluetooth 5.0 technology for stable connectivity.

# Easy Operation

- **Volume - / Previous Track:** Decrease volume or skip to the previous song.
- **Volume + / Next Track:** Increase volume or skip to the next song.
- **MF Button (Multi-function Button):** Power on/off, play/pause, answer/end calls, activate voice assistant.
- **LED Indicator:** Displays power, charging, and Bluetooth status.
- **Charging Connector / Audio Jack:** For charging the headphones or connecting via a wired audio cable.
- **Microphone:** For hands-free calling.

## SETUP

### Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge the headphones. Connect the supplied charging cable to the charging port on the headphones and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall adapter). The LED indicator will show charging status.

- Charging Time: Approximately 2-3 hours for a full charge.

- Battery Life: Up to 20 hours of music/talk time, 1000 hours standby.

# Long Battery Life

BT5 has the amazing battery life and enables you to enjoy music for a long time. 15-20 hours of listening and talking time, 1000 hours of long standby.

## Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the headphones are turned off.
2. Press and hold the **MF button** until the LED indicator flashes blue and red alternately, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, PC), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "Bluedio BT5" from the list of devices.

5. Once successfully paired, the LED indicator will flash blue slowly.

The headphones will automatically connect to the last paired device when turned on, if Bluetooth is enabled on the device and it is within range.

## Wired Connection (Optional)

If the battery is depleted or you prefer a wired connection, you can use a 3.5mm audio cable (not included) to connect the headphones to your audio device. Insert one end into the audio jack on the headphones and the other end into your device's audio output.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the **MF button** for approximately 3 seconds until you hear "Power On" and the blue LED flashes.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the **MF button** for approximately 5 seconds until you hear "Power Off" and the red LED flashes briefly before turning off.

### Music Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Short press the **MF button**.
- **Volume Up:** Short press the **Volume +** button.
- **Volume Down:** Short press the **Volume -** button.
- **Next Track:** Long press the **Volume +** button.
- **Previous Track:** Long press the **Volume -** button.

### Call Management

- **Answer/End Call:** Short press the **MF button**.
- **Reject Call:** Long press the **MF button** for 2 seconds.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double-press the **MF button**.

### Voice Assistant

- **Activate Voice Assistant:** Triple-press the **MF button** to activate your device's voice assistant (e.g., Siri, Google Assistant).

## MAINTENANCE

---

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the headphones. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the headphones in a cool, dry place away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight. The headphones are lightweight and retractable for space-saving storage.

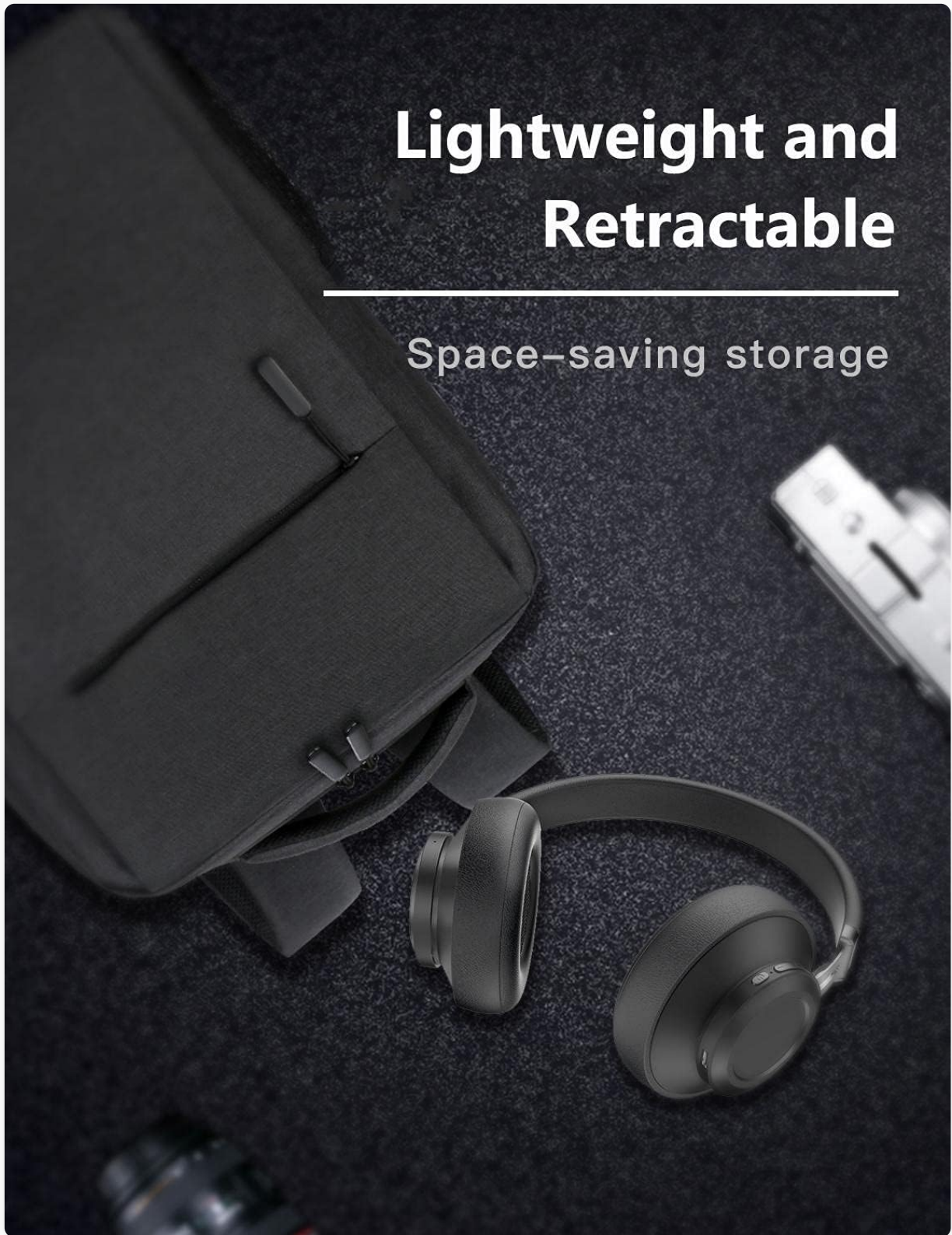


Image: Bluedio BT5 headphones folded and placed next to a backpack, demonstrating their lightweight and retractable design for easy, space-saving storage.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headphones fully.



Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cannot pair with device.	Headphones not in pairing mode; device Bluetooth off; too far from device.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing red/blue). Turn on device Bluetooth. Move headphones closer to device (within 10 meters).
No sound or low volume.	Volume too low on headphones or device; incorrect audio source; headphones not connected.	Increase volume on both headphones and device. Check if headphones are properly connected via Bluetooth or wired.
Poor sound quality.	Interference; low battery; distance from device.	Move away from sources of interference. Charge headphones. Reduce distance to paired device.
