## INSTRUCTION MANUAL - MODEL HHW07

### 1. Introduction

---

Welcome to the Fisher-Price Little People Friendly School Musical Playset. This interactive playset is designed to engage toddlers aged 12 months to 5 years in imaginative play, fostering social skills and fine motor development. It features songs, sounds, and various interactive elements to enhance the learning experience.

The playset includes a schoolhouse structure, two Little People figures, and one play piece, offering a complete and engaging play environment.

### 2. Product Features

---

- **Interactive Schoolhouse:** Playset with engaging songs and sounds that introduce children to making friends and sharing.
- **Discovery Buttons:** Press for educational songs, sounds, phrases, and fun actions.
- **Hands-on Play:** Features a working teeter-totter, spinning globe, and a real metal bell to strengthen fine motor skills.
- **Compact Storage:** Playset folds for convenient storage, keeping the included figures and play piece secure inside.
- **Developmental Benefits:** Encourages imaginative storytelling play and helps strengthen fine motor skills for toddlers and preschool children.

### 3. Setup

---

The Fisher-Price Little People Friendly School Musical Playset comes largely pre-assembled. Minimal setup is required.

1. **Unboxing:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure all pieces listed in the 'What's in the Box' section are present.
2. **Battery Installation:** The playset requires 2 AA batteries (included). Locate the battery compartment, usually on the underside of the main playset unit. Use a Phillips head screwdriver to open the compartment, insert the batteries observing polarity (+/-), and secure the cover.
3. **Unfolding the Playset:** If the playset is in its folded storage configuration, gently unfold the sections until it forms the complete schoolhouse structure. Ensure all connecting points click securely into place.
4. **Placement:** Place the playset on a flat, stable surface for optimal play.

## 4. Operating Instructions

Engage with the playset's various interactive features:

- **Discovery Buttons:** Press the red 'Discovery Buttons' located throughout the playset to activate educational songs, sounds, and phrases. These buttons are designed to introduce concepts like sharing and friendship.
- **Teeter-Totter:** Place Little People figures on the teeter-totter. Press the button nearby to make it move up and down, simulating play.
- **Spinning Globe:** Rotate the globe located on the upper level of the schoolhouse.
- **Metal Bell:** Ring the metal bell by pressing the button above it.
- **Door and Windows:** Open and close the schoolhouse door and interact with the various window scenes to encourage imaginative play.

### 5. Maintenance

To ensure the longevity and hygiene of your playset, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the playset and figures with a damp cloth using mild soap and water. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

- **Drying:** Ensure all parts are thoroughly dry before storing or allowing children to play with them again.
- **Storage:** When not in use, fold the playset for compact storage. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent fading or damage.
- **Battery Care:** If the playset will not be used for an extended period, remove the batteries to prevent leakage and damage.

### 6. Troubleshooting

---

If you encounter any issues with your playset, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **No Sound/Lights:**
  - Check if the batteries are correctly installed with the proper polarity (+/-).
  - Replace old batteries with new AA alkaline batteries.
  - Ensure the playset's power switch (if present) is in the 'ON' position.
- **Figures Not Staying in Place:** Ensure figures are properly seated in designated spots. The playset is designed for Little People figures, and other toy figures may not fit securely.
- **Playset Not Folding/Unfolding Smoothly:** Check for any obstructions or debris in the hinges or connecting points. Apply gentle pressure when folding/unfolding. Do not force the parts.
