1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Rollplay Mini Quad Racing 6V Electric Ride-On. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new vehicle. Please read all instructions carefully before use and retain this manual for future reference. This product is designed for children aged 18 months to 3 years, with a maximum weight capacity of 35 kg.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: To prevent serious injury, adult supervision is required at all times. Never leave children unattended while operating this vehicle. Always ensure the child wears appropriate safety gear, including a helmet, when riding. This product is not intended for use on public roads, near motor vehicles, on or near steep inclines or steps, swimming pools, or other bodies of water. Use only on flat, dry surfaces.

- **Age and Weight Limit:** Suitable for children 18 months to 3 years, maximum weight 35 kg.
- **Battery Safety:** Only use the provided 6V battery and charger. Do not mix old and new batteries. Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- **Charging:** Charge the battery in a dry, well-ventilated area, away from flammable materials.

- **Operation:** Ensure the child's feet are always on the footrests during operation.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please check the package contents to ensure all parts are present:

- Rollplay Mini Quad Racing Electric Ride-On (main unit)
- 6V Rechargeable Battery
- Battery Charger
- Instruction Manual

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

The Rollplay Mini Quad Racing is largely pre-assembled. The primary step required before first use is connecting the battery.

1. **Locate the Battery Compartment:** The battery compartment is located under the seat of the quad. Carefully lift the seat or access panel to expose the compartment.
2. **Connect the Battery:** Inside the compartment, you will find the 6V battery and two wires (typically red and black) with connectors. Match the corresponding connectors from the quad's wiring harness to the battery terminals and firmly push them together until they click into place. Ensure a secure connection.
3. **Secure the Battery:** Place the battery securely within its compartment.
4. **Close Compartment:** Replace the seat or access panel, ensuring it is properly secured before use.

5. CHARGING THE BATTERY

Before first use, charge the battery for a minimum of 8-12 hours, but no more than 20 hours. Subsequent charges should also be 8-12 hours.

1. **Connect Charger:** Locate the charging port on the quad (refer to the diagram in the manual if available, typically near the battery compartment or under the seat). Plug the charger into the charging port.
2. **Plug into Wall Outlet:** Plug the charger into a standard wall outlet. The charger's indicator light (if present) will typically show red during charging and turn green when fully charged.
3. **Disconnect:** Once charging is complete, unplug the charger from the wall outlet first, then from the quad.

Important: Do not overcharge the battery, as this can shorten its lifespan. Always disconnect the charger when not in use.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Rollplay Mini Quad Racing is designed for simple operation, allowing young children to easily control it.

1. **Power On:** Ensure the battery is connected and charged.

2. **Start/Go:** To move forward, press and hold the red button located on the right handlebar. The quad will move at a maximum speed of 3 km/h.
3. **Stop:** Release the red button to stop the quad. The vehicle will come to a gentle stop.
4. **Steering:** Use the handlebars to steer the quad left or right.

7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your Rollplay Mini Quad Racing.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the vehicle with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. Avoid spraying water directly onto electrical components.
- **Battery Care:** Recharge the battery after each use. If storing the vehicle for an extended period, charge the battery once a month to maintain its health. Do not store the battery in extreme temperatures.
- **Tires:** Regularly check the tires for wear and tear.
- **General Inspection:** Periodically check all screws, nuts, and fasteners to ensure they are tight. Inspect the wiring for any damage.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Rollplay Mini Quad Racing, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vehicle does not move	Battery not connected or discharged	Ensure battery is securely connected. Charge the battery for 8-12 hours.
Vehicle moves slowly	Low battery charge or overloaded	Recharge the battery. Ensure the rider's weight does not exceed 35 kg.
Charger indicator light not working	Charger not properly plugged in or faulty	Check connections at both the wall outlet and the vehicle. Try a different outlet. If issue persists, contact support.
