## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper use and care of your Timex TW2V11000LG Men's Watch. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your timepiece. This watch features a durable stainless steel case, a mineral glass crystal, a comfortable nylon strap, and a reliable quartz movement.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Timex TW2V11000LG is a 41mm men's watch designed for everyday wear. It combines functionality with a classic aesthetic. Key components include the watch case, mineral crystal, crown, and nylon strap with a buckle closure.

### 3. SETUP

---

#### 3.1 Setting the Time

1. Pull the crown (the small knob on the side of the watch case) out to position 2.
  2. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the hour and minute hands to the correct time.
  3. Once the time is set, push the crown back into position 1 (normal operating position).
- Note: This watch model does not feature a date display.*

## 4. OPERATING THE WATCH

Your Timex TW2V11000LG watch operates on a quartz movement, providing accurate timekeeping. Once the time is set, the watch will run continuously until the battery requires replacement.

### 4.1 Wearing the Watch

Adjust the nylon strap to a comfortable fit on your wrist using the buckle closure. Ensure the watch is not too tight to allow for proper circulation, but secure enough to prevent excessive movement.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Water Resistance

This watch has a water resistance rating of 5 ATM (50 meters). This means it is suitable for short periods of recreational swimming, but not for diving or snorkeling. Avoid operating the crown while the watch is wet or submerged.

- **Do not** press any buttons or pull the crown while the watch is underwater.
- **Avoid** exposing the watch to hot water, steam, or extreme temperature changes, as this can compromise the water resistance seals.
- After exposure to saltwater, rinse the watch with fresh water and dry it thoroughly.

### 5.2 Cleaning

To clean the watch case and crystal, wipe gently with a soft, damp cloth. For the nylon strap, a mild soap solution and a soft brush can be used, followed by thorough rinsing and air drying. Ensure the watch is completely dry before wearing.

### 5.3 Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a standard watch battery. When the watch stops running, it indicates the battery needs replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and maintain water resistance.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Watch stops running.	Depleted battery.	Replace the battery. Consult a professional watch technician.
Time is incorrect.	Time not set correctly or crown is pulled out.	Refer to "Setting the Time" section. Ensure crown is fully pushed in.
Condensation inside the watch.	Exposure to extreme temperature changes or compromised water resistance.	Seek immediate professional service to prevent damage to the movement.
