# HOMCOM Corner TV Stand Model 839-049 Instruction Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the assembly, setup, operation, and maintenance of your HOMCOM Corner TV Stand, Model 839-049. Designed to fit neatly into room corners, this entertainment center accommodates TVs up to 50 inches and features integrated storage solutions. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning assembly and retain it for future reference.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

### Important Safety Guidelines:

- Assembly required. Keep away from heat sources and excessive moisture.
- Do not place heavy objects on the open back compartment to prevent tip-over.
- Always follow the assembly instructions carefully.
- Ensure all connections are secure before placing a television or other items on the stand.
- Distribute weight evenly across the stand's surfaces.

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before assembly, verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer support.

- All necessary wood panels (top, side, bottom, back, drawer components)
- Hardware pack (screws, dowels, cam locks, drawer slides, handles)
- Instruction manual

## 4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

This product requires assembly. Please follow the detailed instructions provided in the separate assembly guide included with your package. Ensure you have adequate space and the necessary tools (typically a screwdriver) before starting.

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches. Refer to the parts list in your assembly guide to identify each piece.
2. **Assemble Frame:** Begin by connecting the side panels to the base and top panel using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are tightened securely.
3. **Install Drawer Slides:** Attach the drawer slides to the interior side panels as indicated in the assembly guide.
4. **Assemble Drawers:** Construct the two pull-out drawers. Attach the drawer handles.
5. **Insert Drawers:** Carefully slide the assembled drawers onto the installed drawer slides.
6. **Final Checks:** Verify that all screws are tightened and the stand is stable.

## 5. SETUP

Once assembled, position the TV stand in your desired corner location. The trapezoidal design ensures a snug fit. This stand is suitable for televisions up to 50 inches. Ensure the TV's base fits within the 37.5-inch width of the stand's top surface.

## 6. OPERATING THE STORAGE FEATURES

The HOMCOM Corner TV Stand offers versatile storage options:

- **Open Compartment:** Ideal for media devices such as DVD players, gaming consoles, or soundbars. The open back design facilitates easy access for cable management and ventilation.
- **Pull-out Drawers:** Two drawers provide concealed storage for remotes, game controllers, video games, or other small accessories.

## 7. MAINTENANCE

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To maintain the appearance and longevity of your TV stand:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that may damage the finish.
- **Spills:** Clean spills immediately to prevent staining or damage to the engineered wood.
- **Stability Check:** Periodically check all screws and connections to ensure they remain tight and secure.
- **Elevated Design:** The 3.25-inch height of the supporting base allows for easy cleaning underneath the stand.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Wobbly Stand:** Ensure all screws are fully tightened. Check that the stand is placed on a level surface.
- **Drawers Not Sliding Smoothly:** Verify that drawer slides are correctly installed and aligned. Apply a silicone-based lubricant if necessary.
- **Missing Parts:** If any parts were missing upon unboxing, refer to the package contents list and contact customer support for replacements.
- **TV Overhangs:** If your TV exceeds 50 inches or its base is wider than 37.5 inches, it may not fit securely. Consider a different stand or a smaller TV.
