1. INTRODUCTION

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

3.2 Required Tools (Not Included)

- Jigsaw or appropriate cutting tool for countertop material

- Adjustable wrench

3.3 Installation Steps (Countertop)

1. **Prepare the Countertop:** Place the sink upside down on the countertop in the desired location. Trace the outline of the sink onto the countertop. Measure and mark the cut-out line, ensuring it is slightly smaller than the sink's rim to allow for proper support.
2. **Cut the Opening:** Carefully cut the opening in the countertop using a jigsaw or appropriate cutting tool. Ensure the edges are smooth.
3. **Install Faucet and Drain Assembly:** Before placing the sink into the countertop, install the faucet (if applicable) and the drain assembly onto the sink according to their respective instructions. Apply plumber's putty or sealant around the drain opening as required.
4. **Apply Sealant:** Apply a bead of silicone sealant around the perimeter of the countertop opening.
5. **Position the Sink:** Carefully lower the sink into the countertop opening, ensuring it is properly aligned. Press down firmly to create a seal with the silicone.
6. **Secure the Sink:** Attach the mounting clips (if provided with the sink or countertop) to the underside of the sink and tighten them to secure the sink to the countertop.
7. **Connect Plumbing:** Connect the drain pipe to the P-trap and the water supply lines to the faucet. Ensure all connections are tight to prevent leaks.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 General Use

- Ensure the drain stopper is open for proper drainage during use.
- Avoid pouring harsh chemicals or abrasive substances directly into the sink, as this may damage the finish.
- Do not place extremely hot items directly on the sink surface for extended periods, although stainless steel is highly heat resistant.

4.2 Drain Assembly

The sink is equipped with a central drain. Ensure the drain basket is regularly cleared of food debris to prevent clogs and maintain efficient drainage.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care and maintenance will extend the life and preserve the appearance of your Stainless Steel Helmet Sink.

5.1 Daily Cleaning

- After each use, rinse the sink thoroughly with warm water to remove any food particles or residue.
- **Wipe with Dry Cloth:** For best results and to prevent water spots, wipe the sink surface dry with a soft, clean cloth after each use.

5.2 Deep Cleaning

- Use a mild dish soap or a non-abrasive stainless steel cleaner with a soft sponge or cloth.
- Always rub in the direction of the grain of the stainless steel to avoid scratching.
- Rinse thoroughly and dry immediately to prevent water stains.

5.3 What to Avoid

- **Abrasive Cleaners:** Do not use steel wool, abrasive pads, or harsh scouring powders, as these can scratch the surface.
- **Bleach and Acids:** Avoid cleaners containing chlorine bleach, hydrochloric acid, or other strong acids, as they can corrode stainless steel.
- **Metal Objects:** Do not leave steel or cast iron objects in the sink for prolonged periods, as they can cause rust stains.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your Helmet Sink.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Slow Drainage	Food debris or grease buildup in the drain.	Clear the drain basket. Use a drain cleaner suitable for kitchen sinks, or a plunger. For severe clogs, professional help may be required.
Water Spots/Stains	Hard water deposits or not drying the sink after use.	Wipe the sink dry after each use. For existing spots, use a vinegar solution (diluted) or a stainless steel cleaner, then rinse and dry.
Scratches on Surface	Use of abrasive cleaners or sharp objects.	Minor scratches can sometimes be blended with a fine abrasive pad (e.g., Scotch-Brite) rubbing in the direction of the grain. Avoid abrasive materials in the future.
Leaking from Connections	Loose plumbing connections or worn seals.	Tighten all connections. Check and replace any worn washers or seals. If the leak persists, consult a plumber.
