Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the ETA Salvet Animal Bagless Vacuum Cleaner, model ETA151390000. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new appliance. Please read it thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

This vacuum cleaner is designed to provide powerful cleaning, especially effective for homes with pets, thanks to its robust 700W motor and integrated HEPA filters.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury.

- Ensure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to your local mains voltage before connecting.
- Do not use the vacuum cleaner on wet surfaces or to pick up liquids.
- Do not pick up burning or smoking objects, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- Do not pick up hard or sharp objects like glass, nails, screws, or coins, as these can damage the appliance.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of the body away from openings and moving parts.
- Unplug the appliance from the power outlet before cleaning or performing maintenance.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons to avoid a hazard.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPONENTS

The ETA Salvet Animal vacuum cleaner is a bagless canister model designed for efficient cleaning. It comes with several accessories to suit various cleaning needs.

Main Components:

- **Main Unit:** Contains the motor, dust container, and filters.
- **Flexible Hose:** Connects to the main unit and the telescopic tube.
- **Metal Telescopic Tube:** Adjustable length for comfortable reach.
- **Floor Brush:** For general floor cleaning.
- **Crevice Tool:** For narrow spaces and corners.
- **Dust Container:** Transparent, bagless container for collecting dirt (2.2 Liters capacity).
- **HEPA Filters (2x):** High-efficiency particulate air filters for trapping fine dust and allergens.
- **Automatic Cable Winder:** For convenient storage of the power cord.

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to assemble your vacuum cleaner before first use:

1. **Attach the Flexible Hose:** Insert the end of the flexible hose into the suction inlet on the main unit until it clicks securely into place.
2. **Connect the Telescopic Tube:** Attach the other end of the flexible hose to the metal telescopic tube.
3. **Attach the Floor Brush/Accessory:** Connect your desired cleaning accessory (e.g., floor brush, crevice tool) to the end of the telescopic tube.
4. **Adjust Telescopic Tube:** Adjust the length of the telescopic tube to a comfortable height for operation.
5. **Check Dust Container and Filters:** Ensure the dust container is correctly inserted and the HEPA filters are in place before operation.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your ETA Salvet Animal vacuum cleaner is designed for easy and effective cleaning of various surfaces, including hard floors and carpets, and is particularly efficient at picking up pet hair.

1. **Power Connection:** Extend the power cord and plug it into a suitable electrical outlet. The vacuum has a 10-meter operating radius for extended reach.
2. **Power On/Off:** Press the power button (usually marked with **I/O** or a power symbol) on the main unit to start or stop the vacuum cleaner.
3. **Adjust Suction Power:** Use the power control dial (if available) on the main unit to adjust the suction power according to the surface being cleaned. Lower power for delicate fabrics, higher power for hard floors and heavily soiled carpets.
4. **Cleaning:** Move the floor brush or chosen accessory steadily over the surface to be cleaned. The 700W motor and 210W suction power ensure effective dirt removal.
5. **Cord Rewind:** After use, unplug the vacuum cleaner. Press the automatic cable rewind button (usually marked with a plug symbol) to retract the power cord.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your vacuum cleaner. Always unplug the appliance before performing any maintenance.

Emptying the Dust Container:

1. Press the release button to detach the dust container from the main unit.
2. Hold the dust container over a waste bin and open its bottom lid to empty the collected dirt.
3. Close the lid securely and reattach the dust container to the vacuum cleaner until it clicks into place.

Cleaning/Replacing HEPA Filters:

The vacuum cleaner is equipped with 2 HEPA filters. These should be cleaned regularly and replaced periodically (e.g.,

every 6-12 months, depending on usage) to maintain suction power and air filtration efficiency.

1. Remove the dust container as described above.
2. Locate and carefully remove the HEPA filters from the dust container and/or the main unit (consult diagrams in the full manual for exact locations).
3. Tap the filters gently over a waste bin to remove loose dust. For a more thorough clean, rinse the filters under cold running water. Do NOT use detergents or hot water.
4. Allow the filters to air dry completely for at least 24 hours before reinserting them. Do NOT use a hairdryer or other heating devices.
5. Once completely dry, reinsert the filters and reattach the dust container.

Cleaning Accessories and Hoses:

- Wipe down accessories with a damp cloth. Ensure they are dry before reattaching.
- Check the hose and telescopic tube for blockages. Remove any obstructions carefully.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your vacuum cleaner, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum cleaner does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet faulty; power button not pressed.	Check power cord connection; try another outlet; press power button firmly.
Low suction power.	Dust container full; filters clogged; hose/tube/accessory blocked.	Empty dust container; clean/replace filters; check and clear blockages.
Unusual noise during operation.	Blockage in hose/tube/accessory; foreign object in brush; motor issue.	Check for and remove blockages; inspect brush for trapped debris. If noise persists, contact customer support.
Dust escaping from vacuum.	Dust container not properly closed; filters incorrectly installed or damaged.	Ensure dust container is securely closed; check filter installation; replace damaged filters.
