1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Razer Wolverine V2 Chroma Wired Gaming Pro Controller. Designed for use with Xbox Series X|S, Xbox One, and PC, this controller offers advanced customization and performance features.

2. KEY FEATURES

The Razer Wolverine V2 Chroma controller incorporates several features designed to enhance your gaming experience:

- **Razer Chroma RGB Lighting:** Customize your controller's lighting with 16.8 million colors and various effects using the Razer Controller Setup for Xbox App.
- **6 Additional Remappable Buttons:** Gain a competitive edge with four extra triggers and two remappable bumpers, configurable via the Razer Controller Setup for Xbox App.
- **Hair Trigger Mode with Trigger Stop-Switches:** Reduce trigger travel distance for faster actuation in competitive scenarios by activating the two slide-locks located on the underside of the controller.
- **Mecha-Tactile Action Buttons and D-Pad:** Experience responsive actuation with a cushioned touch and enhanced tactile feedback for precise command execution.
- **Interchangeable Thumbstick Caps:** Adapt to different play styles with included short and extended grip thumbstick

caps for natural and precise analog motion.

- **Improved Ergonomics:** The controller features modified L-shaped handgrips with non-slip rubber for a secure and comfortable hold during extended gaming sessions.
- **Designed for Xbox:** Officially licensed and developed in collaboration with Xbox to ensure optimal compatibility and performance.

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Package Contents

- Razer Wolverine V2 Chroma Wired Gaming Pro Controller
- Detachable USB-C to USB-A Cable
- Interchangeable Thumbstick Caps (Short and Extended)
- Important Product Information Guide

3.2 Connecting the Controller

1. Connect the USB-C end of the provided cable to the port on the top of the Razer Wolverine V2 Chroma controller.
2. Connect the USB-A end of the cable to an available USB port on your Xbox console (Xbox Series X|S, Xbox One) or PC.
3. The controller will automatically be detected and configured by your system.

3.3 Installing the Razer Controller Setup for Xbox App

For full customization of your controller's features, including button remapping and Chroma RGB lighting, download and install the Razer Controller Setup for Xbox App.

- On Xbox: Search for "Razer Controller Setup for Xbox" in the Xbox Store.
- On PC: Search for "Razer Controller Setup for Xbox" in the Microsoft Store.

Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation and begin customizing your controller.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Remapping Buttons

The Razer Wolverine V2 Chroma features six additional remappable buttons (M1-M6). These can be configured to perform various functions using the Razer Controller Setup for Xbox App.

1. Ensure your controller is connected and the Razer Controller Setup for Xbox App is open.
2. Navigate to the button remapping section within the app.
3. Select the desired M-button and assign it to any standard controller input (e.g., A, B, X, Y, D-pad directions, bumper, trigger).
4. Save your profile.

4.2 Activating Hair Trigger Mode

Hair Trigger Mode significantly reduces the travel distance of the main triggers (LT/RT), allowing for faster firing in games. This mode is activated via physical switches on the controller.

1. Locate the two slide-locks on the underside of the controller, beneath the main triggers.
2. Slide the locks to the engaged position to activate Hair Trigger Mode for the corresponding trigger.
3. Slide the locks back to the disengaged position to return to standard trigger travel.

4.3 Changing Thumbstick Caps

The controller comes with interchangeable thumbstick caps to suit different preferences and gaming styles.

1. Gently pull upwards on the existing thumbstick cap to remove it.
2. Align the desired new thumbstick cap (short or extended) with the thumbstick base.
3. Press down firmly until the cap clicks securely into place.

4.4 Customizing Chroma RGB Lighting

1. Open the Razer Controller Setup for Xbox App.
2. Navigate to the Chroma lighting section.
3. Select from various lighting effects, colors, and brightness levels.
4. Apply your chosen settings to the controller.

4.5 Mecha-Tactile Action Buttons and D-Pad

The controller features Razer Mecha-Tactile Action Buttons and a Mecha-Tactile D-Pad, engineered for precise and satisfying feedback with every press. These buttons combine the soft, cushioned touch of a membrane switch with the crisp, tactile feedback of a mechanical switch.

4.6 Ergonomics

The controller's improved ergonomic design, featuring modified L-shaped handgrips and non-slip rubber surfaces, ensures a comfortable and secure grip, reducing fatigue during prolonged gaming sessions.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Controller

- Ensure the controller is disconnected from your console or PC before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to wipe down the surface of the controller.
- For stubborn dirt, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaning solution. Avoid excessive moisture.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or solvents, as these can damage the controller's finish and internal components.
- Use a cotton swab or compressed air to clean around buttons, thumbsticks, and crevices.

5.2 Storage

When not in use, store the controller in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid placing heavy objects on the controller to prevent damage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1 Controller Not Responding

- **Check Cable Connection:** Ensure the USB-C cable is securely connected to both the controller and the console/PC. Try unplugging and re-plugging the cable.
- **Try a Different USB Port:** Connect the controller to a different USB port on your console or PC to rule out a faulty port.
- **Restart Console/PC:** A system restart can often resolve connectivity issues.
- **Test on Another Device:** If possible, test the controller on another compatible Xbox console or PC to determine if the issue is with the controller or the original device.

6.2 Customization Settings Not Applying

- **Razer Controller Setup App:** Ensure the Razer Controller Setup for Xbox App is installed and up to date.
- **Controller Connected:** Verify that the controller is connected and recognized by the app.
- **Save Profile:** Make sure you have saved any changes made within the app to your controller profile.

6.3 RGB Lighting Issues

- **App Settings:** Check the Chroma lighting settings within the Razer Controller Setup for Xbox App. Ensure lighting is enabled and configured as desired.
- **Software Update:** Ensure both the controller firmware and the Razer Controller Setup for Xbox App are updated to the latest versions.
