1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your VIVOHOME Glass Countertop Display Showcase. This product package includes two distinct display units: one measuring 16 inches (W) x 16 inches (D) x 34 inches (H) and another measuring 15.7 inches (W) x 15.7 inches (D) x 47.2 inches (H). Both units are designed to offer secure and clear display solutions for various items.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always handle glass components with care to prevent breakage and injury. Wear protective gloves if necessary.
- Ensure the display showcase is assembled on a flat, stable, and level surface to prevent tipping.
- Do not overload the shelves. Each shelf has a maximum weight capacity of 33 lbs (15 kg). Distribute weight evenly.
- Keep assembly hardware and small parts away from children and pets.
- The security lock is designed to deter unauthorized access. Keep keys in a safe place and out of reach of children.
- Avoid placing the showcase in high-traffic areas where it could be easily bumped or knocked over.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact VIVOHOME customer support.

- Tempered Glass Panels (sides, door, shelves)
- MDF Top and Base Panels
- Security Lock with Keys
- Heavy-Duty Metal Connectors / Hinges

- Assembly Hardware (screws, bolts, tools if included)
- Instruction Manual

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of the VIVOHOME Glass Countertop Display Showcase is designed to be straightforward. It is recommended to have a second person assist with handling glass panels for safety and ease of assembly.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Lay them out on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. **Attach Base Panel:** Secure the side glass panels to the MDF base panel using the provided connectors and hardware. Ensure the grooves align correctly.
3. **Insert Shelves:** Slide the tempered glass shelves into the designated slots or attach them to the support brackets at the desired height. Ensure they are firmly seated.
4. **Attach Top Panel:** Secure the MDF top panel to the assembled glass structure using the remaining connectors and hardware.
5. **Install Door and Hinges:** Attach the glass door to the side panel using the provided hinges. Ensure the door swings freely and aligns properly with the cabinet opening.
6. **Install Security Lock:** Mount the security lock mechanism onto the door and frame as per the specific lock instructions. Test the lock functionality.




Image: Fully assembled VIVOHOME Glass Display Showcase, demonstrating its transparent design and storage capacity.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Using the Security Lock

Your VIVOHOME display showcase is equipped with a glass security lock to protect your displayed items.

- **To Lock:** Close the glass door completely. Insert the key into the lock cylinder and turn it clockwise until the locking mechanism engages. Remove the key.
- **To Unlock:** Insert the key into the lock cylinder and turn it counter-clockwise until the locking mechanism disengages. The door can now be opened.

5.2 Placing Items on Shelves

When placing items inside the showcase, adhere to the following guidelines:

- Ensure items do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 33 lbs (15 kg) per shelf.
- Distribute the weight evenly across the shelf surface to maintain stability.
- Avoid placing excessively tall or wide items that could obstruct the door's closing mechanism or put pressure on the glass panels.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and appearance of your display showcase.

- **Glass Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth and a non-abrasive glass cleaner. Spray the cleaner onto the cloth, not directly onto the glass, to avoid dripping onto other materials. Wipe gently until clean and streak-free.
- **MDF Panels:** Wipe the top and base MDF panels with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or excessive moisture, which can damage the finish.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check all screws and connectors to ensure they are tight. Retighten if necessary, but do not overtighten.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the glass for any chips or cracks. If damage occurs, discontinue use and consider replacement of the affected panel.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your VIVOHOME Glass Countertop Display Showcase, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Cabinet is Unstable/Wobbly:**

- Ensure the showcase is placed on a completely flat and level surface.
- Check all assembly hardware (screws, connectors) to ensure they are securely tightened.

- **Door Does Not Close or Lock Properly:**

- Verify that the hinges are correctly installed and aligned. Adjust if necessary.
- Check for any obstructions preventing the door from closing fully.
- Inspect the lock mechanism for any misalignment or damage.

- **Glass Panel Appears Loose:**

- Immediately cease using the cabinet.
- Check the connectors securing the panel. If they are loose, gently tighten them. If the panel is damaged, it must be replaced.
