For RCA Smart TV Models: RNSMU4336, RNSMU5036, RNSMU6036, RNSMU5536, RNSMU5536REM, RNSMU6536, RNSMU7036, RNSMU7036-B, RNSMU5836, RNSMU8220, RNSMU7536-B, RHOS581SM-D

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the Easytry123 replacement remote control, designed for use with various RCA Smart TV models. This remote offers essential functions for controlling your television. Please note that as a replacement unit, some advanced or specific functions of your original remote may not be fully supported.

2. SETUP

2.1 Battery Installation

The remote control requires two (2) AA batteries (not included). Follow these steps to install them:

1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control.
2. Press down on the tab and slide the cover downwards to remove it.
3. Insert two AA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the markings inside the compartment.
4. Slide the battery compartment cover back into place until it clicks securely.

2.2 Initial Use

This replacement remote control uses infrared (IR) technology and typically does not require programming. Once batteries are installed, point the remote directly at your RCA TV and press the **POWER** button to test functionality. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR receiver.

3. OPERATING THE REMOTE CONTROL

The remote control features a standard layout for easy navigation and control of your RCA TV. Below is a general guide to the main button functions:

- **POWER (Red Button)**: Turns the TV on or off.
- **MUTE**: Mutes or unmutes the TV audio.
- **Number Pad (0-9)**: Directly input channel numbers.
- **BACK/RETURN**: Returns to the previous menu or screen.
- **MENU**: Accesses the TV's main menu.
- **SOURCE**: Selects input sources (e.g., HDMI 1, AV, TV).
- **Navigation Buttons (Up, Down, Left, Right)**: Navigate through menus and options.
- **OK**: Confirms selections in menus.
- **HOME** (House icon): Returns to the TV's home screen or smart TV interface.
- **EXIT**: Exits the current menu or application.
- **VOL +/-**: Adjusts the volume level.

- **CH +/-:** Changes TV channels.
- **INFO:** Displays information about the current program or input.
- **EPG:** Accesses the Electronic Program Guide.
- **CC/SUBTITLE:** Toggles Closed Captions or subtitles.
- **MTS:** Selects Multi-channel Television Sound options.
- **REC:** Initiates recording (if supported by TV and connected device).
- **CH LIST:** Displays the channel list.
- **FAV:** Accesses favorite channels.
- **QUICK:** Provides quick access to certain functions (functionality may vary by TV model).
- **Colored Buttons (Red, Green, Yellow, Blue):** These buttons perform specific functions depending on the TV menu or application.
- **Media Control Buttons** (Play/Pause, Rewind, Fast Forward, Stop): Control media playback.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning

To clean the remote control, use a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials, as they may damage the remote's surface or internal components.

4.2 Battery Replacement

Replace batteries when the remote control's response becomes sluggish or stops working. Always replace both batteries at the same time with new AA batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Remote is not working:**
 - Ensure batteries are installed correctly with the correct polarity (+/-).
 - Replace old batteries with new ones.
 - Point the remote directly at the TV's infrared receiver.
 - Remove any obstructions between the remote and the TV.
 - Confirm the TV is powered on.
- **Some functions are not working:**
 - As a replacement remote, certain advanced or specific functions of your original TV remote may not be supported. This is normal for universal or replacement remotes.
 - Ensure your TV model is listed as compatible in the product description.




