# Hasbro Gaming Scrabble Board Game Instruction Manual

Model: F4204

## 1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the classic game of Scrabble by Hasbro Gaming. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, playing, and maintaining your Scrabble board game. Scrabble is a word game for 2 to 4 players, where participants score points by placing tiles, each bearing a single letter, onto a game board. The words are formed crossword-style in horizontal or vertical rows and must be found in a standard dictionary.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

**WARNING: Small parts may be generated. Not for children under 3 years.**

Please ensure all game components are handled appropriately and kept away from young children to prevent choking hazards.

## 3. COMPONENTS (WHAT'S IN THE BOX)

Your Hasbro Gaming Scrabble Board Game includes the following components:

- 1 Gameboard
- 100 Wooden Letter Tiles
- 4 Wooden Tile Racks
- 1 Drawstring Letter Bag
- Game Rules

## 4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Scrabble game:

1. **Place the Gameboard:** Unfold the gameboard and place it on a flat, stable surface where all players can comfortably reach it.
2. **Prepare the Letter Tiles:** Place all 100 wooden letter tiles into the drawstring letter bag. Shake the bag thoroughly to mix the tiles.
3. **Draw Initial Tiles:** Each player draws seven tiles from the bag without looking. Place these tiles on your wooden tile rack, keeping them concealed from other players.
4. **Determine First Player:** The player who drew the letter closest to 'A' goes first. A blank tile is considered to be 'A'. If there's a tie, those players draw again. Return all drawn tiles to the bag and re-mix before drawing again for the game.

## 5. OPERATING (HOW TO PLAY)

### 5.1. Gameplay Overview

Players take turns forming words on the gameboard using their letter tiles. Words can be formed horizontally or vertically, and must connect to existing words on the board. The goal is to score the most points by the end of the game.

### 5.2. Forming Words

- The first player places a word that covers the center star square on the board.
- Subsequent players build upon existing words, either by adding letters to them, forming new words that intersect with existing ones, or placing a complete word parallel to an existing word so that adjacent letters also form complete words.
- All letters played in a single turn must be in one continuous line, either horizontally or vertically.
- Words must be found in a standard dictionary. Proper nouns, abbreviations, and words requiring hyphens or apostrophes are not allowed.

### 5.3. Scoring



Each letter tile has a point value. These values are added up for each word formed. Special squares on the board multiply the score of letters or entire words:

- **Double Letter Score (Light Blue):** The letter placed on this square is worth double its normal value.
- **Triple Letter Score (Dark Blue):** The letter placed on this square is worth triple its normal value.
- **Double Word Score (Pink):** The entire word formed is worth double its total value.
- **Triple Word Score (Red):** The entire word formed is worth triple its total value.
- **Center Star Square:** This is a Double Word Score square for the first word played.
- **Bingo:** If a player uses all seven tiles from their rack in a single turn, they receive a bonus of 50 points in addition to the score for the word.

#### 5.4. End of Turn

After playing a word and scoring, the player draws new tiles from the bag to replenish their rack to seven tiles. Play then passes to the next player.

#### 5.5. Passing and Exchanging Tiles

- **Passing:** A player may choose to pass their turn, scoring zero points.
- **Exchanging Tiles:** A player may choose to exchange one or more tiles from their rack for new

ones from the bag. This counts as a turn, and no points are scored. This can only be done if there are at least seven tiles remaining in the bag.

### 5.6. Ending the Game

The game ends when:

- One player has used all the tiles on their rack, and there are no more tiles in the bag.
- All possible plays have been made, or all players pass two consecutive turns.

When the game ends, each player's score is adjusted: subtract the sum of their unplayed tiles from their score. If a player has used all their tiles, they add the sum of all unplayed tiles remaining on other players' racks to their score. The player with the highest final score wins.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity of your Scrabble game:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the gameboard and wooden components with a dry, soft cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or excessive moisture.
- **Storage:** Store all components in the original box in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure all tiles are returned to the drawstring bag to prevent loss.
- **Handling:** Handle wooden tiles and racks with care to prevent damage or splintering.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Most issues with the Scrabble game are related to rules interpretation or missing components.

- **Missing Components:** If any components are missing upon opening the box, please contact Hasbro Gaming customer support.
- **Rule Disputes:** Refer to the included game rules booklet for clarification. For complex disputes, a mutually agreed-upon dictionary can serve as the final authority for word validity.
- **Damaged Components:** If components are damaged, contact customer support for possible replacements.
