INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the PowerLocus P1 Kids Bluetooth Headphones. These headphones are designed with an 85dB volume limit for hearing protection, offering both wireless Bluetooth and wired connectivity. They include a built-in microphone, FM radio, and Micro SD card support, making them versatile for various uses such as music, online learning, and travel.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The PowerLocus P1 headphones feature a foldable design for portability, soft earmuffs for comfort, and intuitive button controls on the ear cup.

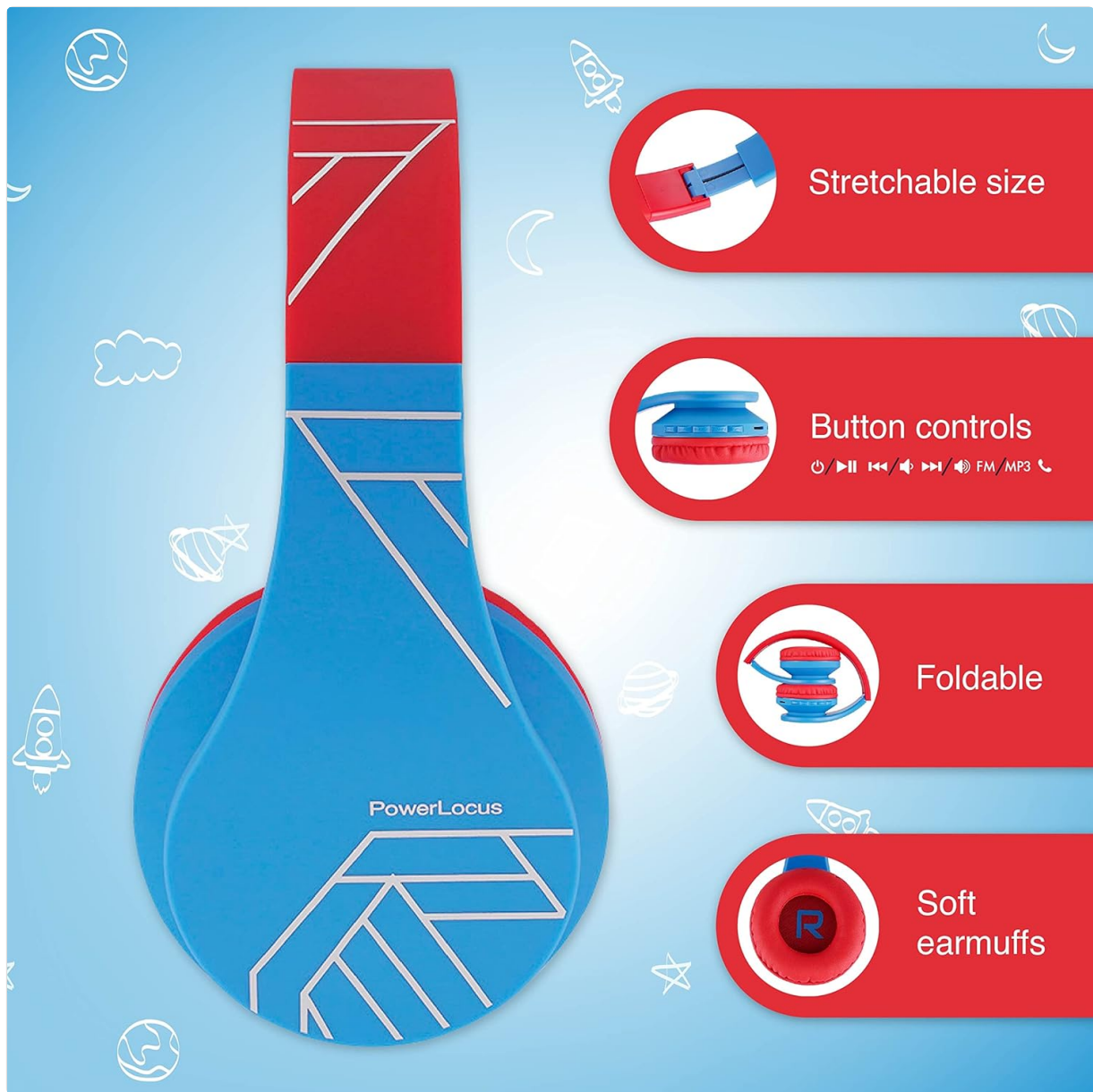


Image: An illustration highlighting key features: stretchable size adjustment, button controls, foldable design, and soft earmuffs.

Controls and Ports:

- **Power Button:** On/Off, Play/Pause (short press), Answer/End Call (short press).
- **Volume Up / Next Track:** Short press for Volume Up, Long press for Next Track.
- **Volume Down / Previous Track:** Short press for Volume Down, Long press for Previous Track.
- **Mode Button (M):** Switch between Bluetooth, FM Radio, and Micro SD modes.
- **Microphone:** For hands-free calls and online learning.
- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** For wired connection.
- **Micro USB Charging Port:** For charging the headphones.
- **Micro SD Card Slot:** For playing music directly from a Micro SD card.

SETUP

1. Charging the Headphones

1. Connect the provided USB charging cable to the Micro USB port on the headphones.
2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter).
3. The LED indicator will illuminate during charging and turn off when fully charged.
4. A full charge takes approximately 2 hours and provides up to 15 hours of playback.

2. Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button until the LED indicator flashes.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until the LED indicator turns off.

3. Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the headphones are charged and powered on. The LED indicator will flash, indicating pairing mode.
2. On your device (smartphone, tablet, PC), enable Bluetooth.
3. Search for "PowerLocus P1" in the list of available Bluetooth devices.

4. Select "PowerLocus P1" to connect. The LED indicator will turn solid blue once connected.
5. The headphones will automatically reconnect to the last paired device when powered on, if within range.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Volume Control and Track Navigation

- **Volume Up:** Short press the "Volume Up / Next Track" button.
- **Volume Down:** Short press the "Volume Down / Previous Track" button.
- **Next Track:** Long press the "Volume Up / Next Track" button.
- **Previous Track:** Long press the "Volume Down / Previous Track" button.
- **Play/Pause:** Short press the Power button.

Note: The headphones have an 85dB volume limit to protect hearing.

2. Answering/Ending Calls

- **Answer Call:** Short press the Power button when a call comes in.

- **End Call:** Short press the Power button during a call.
- **Reject Call:** Long press the Power button when a call comes in.

3. Wired Mode (AUX)

1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the headphone's AUX port.
2. Connect the other end to your audio device's 3.5mm audio jack.
3. The headphones will automatically switch to wired mode. Bluetooth functions will be disabled.

4. FM Radio Mode

1. Power on the headphones.
2. Press the "M" (Mode) button to switch to FM Radio mode.
3. Long press the "Play/Pause" button to automatically scan and save available FM stations.
4. Use the "Next Track" and "Previous Track" buttons to navigate between saved stations.

5. Micro SD Card Playback

1. Insert a Micro SD card (with MP3 files) into the Micro SD card slot on the headphones.
2. Press the "M" (Mode) button to switch to Micro SD mode.
3. Music will automatically start playing from the card.
4. Use the "Volume Up/Next Track" and "Volume Down/Previous Track" buttons to control playback.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the headphones. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the headphones in the provided hard shell protective case to prevent damage. Avoid exposing them to extreme temperatures or humidity.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, charge the headphones regularly, even if not used frequently. Avoid fully discharging the battery for extended periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Low battery.	Charge the headphones using the provided USB cable.
Cannot pair via Bluetooth.	Bluetooth not enabled on device; headphones not in pairing mode; too far from device.	Ensure Bluetooth is on your device. Power off and on the headphones to re-enter pairing mode. Move headphones closer to the device (within 10 meters).
No sound in Bluetooth mode.	Volume too low; not connected; incorrect audio output selected on device.	Increase headphone and device volume. Re-pair the headphones. Check device's audio output settings.
Microphone not working.	Microphone muted on device; incorrect input device selected.	Check device's microphone settings and ensure "PowerLocus P1" is selected as the input device.
FM radio not receiving stations.	Poor signal; stations not scanned.	Move to an area with better signal. Long press the Play/Pause button to auto-scan for stations.
Micro SD card not playing.	Card not inserted correctly; unsupported file format; card corrupted.	Reinsert the Micro SD card. Ensure files are in MP3 format. Try a different Micro SD card.
