1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Microsoft Surface Pro Signature Keyboard. Designed for seamless integration with Surface Pro 8 and Surface Pro X, this premium keyboard enhances your productivity with a full mechanical keyset, backlit keys, and a large glass trackpad. 2. SETUP

2.1 Attaching the Keyboard

The Surface Pro Signature Keyboard connects magnetically to your compatible Surface Pro device. Align the keyboard's magnetic connector with the port on the bottom edge of your Surface Pro until it clicks securely into place.

2.2 Initial Connection and Pairing

Once physically attached, the keyboard should automatically connect. If prompted, follow on-screen instructions to complete any necessary driver installations or Bluetooth pairing. The keyboard draws power directly from the Surface Pro, so no separate charging is required for the keyboard itself.

2.3 Surface Slim Pen 2 Integration (Sold Separately)

The keyboard features a dedicated storage and charging slot for the Surface Slim Pen 2. Place the pen in the recessed area above the function keys. The pen will magnetically attach and begin charging. This ensures your pen is always ready for use and securely stored.



3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Typing and Trackpad Usage

The keyboard provides a full mechanical keyset for a responsive typing experience. The integrated large glass trackpad allows for precise navigation and multi-touch gestures. Refer to your Surface Pro's operating system settings for customizing trackpad gestures.

3.2 Backlit Keys

The keys are backlit for visibility in low-light conditions. Adjust the backlight brightness using the dedicated function keys (e.g., F5 and F6, or similar icons depending on your keyboard layout). The backlight typically has multiple brightness levels.

3.3 Adjustable Angle

The keyboard can be adjusted to various angles for comfortable typing. When attached, you can slightly tilt the keyboard upwards by folding the magnetic strip near the hinge, creating a more ergonomic typing position.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning the Keyboard

To clean the Alcantara material, gently wipe with a lint-free cloth dampened with a mild soap and water solution. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. For the keys and trackpad, use a soft, dry cloth. Ensure the keyboard is disconnected from the Surface Pro before cleaning.

4.2 Storage

When not in use, fold the keyboard over the screen to protect both the display and the keyboard keys. This also helps conserve battery life of the Surface Pro.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 Keyboard Not Responding

- Ensure the keyboard is securely attached to the Surface Pro. Detach and reattach it.
- Restart your Surface Pro device.
- Check for any pending Windows updates that might include keyboard driver updates.
- If using a Bluetooth connection (for some models), ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your Surface Pro and the keyboard is paired.

5.2 Backlight Not Working

- Press the backlight function keys (e.g., F5/F6) to adjust brightness.
- Ensure your Surface Pro's battery is not critically low, as backlighting may be disabled to conserve power.

5.3 Trackpad Issues

- Clean the trackpad surface to remove any dirt or debris.
- Check Surface Pro settings for trackpad sensitivity and gesture configurations.
