Setup

- 4. **Connect Accessories (Sold Separately):** If you have a Surface Pro Signature Keyboard or Surface Slim Pen 2, attach the keyboard to the magnetic port at the bottom edge of the Surface Pro 8. The pen can be paired via Bluetooth or stored in the keyboard's charging slot.




Figure 4: Surface Pro 8 in laptop configuration.


