NORFIN Extreme 5 Bibs Instruction Manual

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The NORFIN Extreme 5 Bibs are high-performance insulated fishing pants designed for extreme cold weather conditions, including ice fishing, boat fishing, and snowmobiling. They are constructed with advanced materials to provide warmth, waterproofing, and breathability, ensuring comfort and protection in harsh environments.

2. KEY FEATURES

These bibs incorporate several key features for optimal performance:

- **Versatile Use:** Designed primarily for ice fishing, also suitable for fishing from a boat and snowmobiling.
- **Advanced Material:** Made from NORTEX BREATHABLE, a lightweight, waterproof, and breathable fabric.
- **Superior Insulation:** Features 120G HOLLOFIL insulation, providing warmth in temperatures as low as -50°F (when paired with the Extreme 5 parka and liner, sold separately).
- **Thermal Regulation:** NORTEX BREATHABLE material effectively holds warm air and retains body heat,

while allowing excess moisture and sweat to escape.

- **High Performance Ratings:** Offers 12,000 mm waterproofing and 8,000 g/m² / 24 hours breathability.

3. SETUP AND WEARING INSTRUCTIONS

To ensure maximum comfort and protection, follow these steps when putting on your NORFIN Extreme 5 Bibs:

1. **Step 1: Donning the Bibs:** Step into the bibs, pulling them up over your legs and torso.
2. **Step 2: Adjusting Shoulder Straps:** Fasten the buckles on the shoulder straps. Adjust the strap length using the sliders to ensure a snug yet comfortable fit. The bibs should not feel too tight or too loose, allowing for full range of motion.
3. **Step 3: Securing Zippers and Closures:** Ensure all main zippers and pocket zippers are fully closed to prevent snow or water entry.
4. **Step 4: Leg Openings:** Utilize the side leg zippers for easier donning over boots. Once your boots are on, zip up the leg openings and secure any hook-and-loop fasteners to seal out elements.

4. OPERATING AND USAGE

The NORFIN Extreme 5 Bibs are designed for active use in cold and wet conditions. To maximize their performance and your comfort:

- **Layering:** For optimal warmth, especially in temperatures down to -50°F, wear appropriate base and mid-layers underneath the bibs. These bibs are designed to be used in combination with the NORFIN Extreme 5 parka and liner (sold separately).
- **Pocket Utilization:** Utilize the various pockets for storing essential gear. The chest pocket, for example, is ideal for small items that need to be easily accessible.
- **Mobility:** The design allows for freedom of movement, crucial for activities like ice fishing, casting, or operating a snowmobile.
- **Ventilation:** While highly insulated, the NORTEX BREATHABLE material helps manage moisture. Avoid overheating by adjusting your activity level or layers if necessary.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will extend the life and maintain the performance of your NORFIN Extreme 5 Bibs. Always refer to the care label inside the garment for specific instructions.

Washing Instructions:

- **Machine Wash:** The bibs are machine washable. Use a gentle cycle with cold or lukewarm water.
- **Detergent:** Use a mild, non-detergent soap specifically designed for technical outerwear, or a small amount of liquid laundry detergent. Avoid powder detergents, fabric softeners, bleach, and stain removers, as these can damage the waterproof and breathable membranes.
- **Preparation:** Before washing, close all zippers and hook-and-loop fasteners. Turn the garment inside out to protect the outer fabric.
- **Drying:** Air dry the bibs by hanging them in a well-ventilated area away from direct sunlight or heat. Do not tumble dry, iron, or dry clean.
- **Storage:** Store the bibs in a cool, dry place when not in use. Ensure they are completely dry before storing to prevent mildew.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your NORFIN Extreme 5 Bibs, consider the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Feeling cold despite insulation	Insufficient layering; extreme temperatures; moisture buildup.	Ensure proper base and mid-layers are worn. Verify bibs are paired with Extreme 5 parka/liner for -50°F rating. Ensure bibs are clean to maintain breathability.
Bibs feel damp inside	Excessive sweating; reduced breathability due to dirt; water penetration.	Adjust activity level to reduce sweating. Clean bibs as per care instructions. Check for any tears or damage to the outer fabric.
Water seeping through fabric	Damage to waterproof membrane; worn DWR (Durable Water Repellent) coating; open zippers.	Inspect for tears or punctures. Ensure all zippers are fully closed. Consider re-applying a DWR treatment if the outer fabric is wetting out.
Stiffness or reduced flexibility	Buildup of dirt or detergent residue; extreme cold.	Wash bibs thoroughly following care instructions. The material may naturally stiffen slightly in very low temperatures.
