SETUP

Battery Installation

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the scale.
2. Open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert the required batteries (typically AAA, refer to packaging for specific type), ensuring correct polarity (+/-) as indicated inside the compartment.
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

Initial Placement

Place the scale on a hard, flat, and stable surface. Uneven surfaces or soft materials can significantly affect measurement accuracy.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Turning On/Off

To turn on the scale, press the **ON/OFF** button. The display will illuminate and show "0" or "0.0" when it is ready for use. To turn off the scale, press and hold the **ON/OFF** button. The scale also features an automatic shut-off function, activating after approximately 2 minutes of inactivity to conserve battery life.

Changing Measurement Units

Press the **UNIT** button to cycle through the available measurement units. The scale supports grams (g), kilograms (kg), pounds (lb), ounces (oz), milliliters (ml), and liters (l).

Weighing Ingredients (Tare Function)

1. Place an empty container on the scale's weighing surface.
2. Press the **TARE** button. The display will reset to "0", effectively subtracting the weight of the container.
3. Add your ingredients to the container. The scale will display the net weight of the ingredients.
4. To weigh additional ingredients in the same container, press **TARE** again after adding each ingredient to reset the display to "0" before adding the next item.

Maximum Capacity

The scale has a maximum weight capacity of 11 lbs (5 kg). Exceeding this limit can damage the internal sensors and affect accuracy.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Cleaning

The tempered glass surface is designed for easy cleaning. Use a soft, damp cloth with a mild, non-abrasive detergent. Wipe the surface dry immediately after cleaning. **Do not use abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or immerse the scale in water.**

Storage

Store the scale in a dry place at room temperature. Avoid exposing it to extreme temperatures, high humidity, or direct sunlight, which can affect its electronic components.

Battery Replacement

When the low battery indicator appears on the display, replace the batteries promptly to ensure continued accuracy and proper function of the scale.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Scale does not turn on	Dead batteries or incorrect battery installation	Replace batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
Inaccurate readings	Uneven surface, overloaded scale, or low battery	Place the scale on a flat, stable surface. Do not exceed capacity. Replace batteries if low.
"Err" message on display	Scale overloaded	Remove items exceeding the 11 lbs (5 kg) capacity.
Display flickers or is dim	Low battery	Replace batteries.


