

5. SETUP AND PAIRING


5.1 Initial Setup (Wireless Mode)

Follow these steps to pair your headset with a Bluetooth-enabled device:

- 1. Power On: Power on the headset. A blue light will illuminate to indicate it is on.
- 2. Pairing Mode: Wait for the voice prompt "Pairing". This confirms the headset is ready to connect.
- 3. **Device Bluetooth Settings:** On your device (e.g., smartphone, tablet), navigate to the Bluetooth settings.
- 4. **Search and Connect:** Search for available devices. You should see "Cellet" or "EBBOOMM100" appear in the list. Select it to connect.
- 5. **Connection Confirmation:** Once connected, the Bluetooth Headset will flash blue approximately every 8 seconds, indicating a successful connection.

5.2 Wired Mode Connection

For wired use, simply connect the provided 3.5mm audio cable to the headset's audio jack and to your device's 3.5mm audio port. The headset will function without power in wired mode, providing continuous audio.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Power On/Off

To power on the headset, press and hold the Multifunctional button until the blue indicator light appears. To power off, press and hold the Multifunctional button again until the light turns off.

6.2 Call Management

• Answer/End Call: Press the Multifunctional button once.

• Reject Call: Press and hold the Multifunctional button for approximately 2 seconds.

6.3 Music Playback

• Play/Pause: Press the Multifunctional button once.

Note: Volume control is typically managed directly from your connected device.

7. CHARGING

To charge your Work PRO Wireless Headset, connect the provided USB Type-C charging cable to the headset's charging port and to a compatible USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter).

- A full charge takes approximately 1.5 hours.
- The charging indicator light will show the charging status (refer to the light behavior section in the full manual if available).
- Important: A USB wall charger is NOT included. Please use any standard USB charger compatible with your device.

8. MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity of your headset:

- Cleaning: Clean the headset regularly with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use.
- Avoid Liquids: Do not expose the headset to water or other liquids.
- Disassembly: Do not attempt to disassemble or modify the headset, as this will void the warranty.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your headset, please refer to the following common solutions:

9.1 No Power

• Ensure the headset is fully charged. Connect it to a power source using the USB Type-C cable.

9.2 Cannot Pair with Device

- Make sure the headset is in pairing mode (blue light flashing, "Pairing" prompt).
- Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device.
- Move the headset closer to your device (within 30 feet).
- Forget previous pairings for "Cellet" or "EBBOOMM100" on your device's Bluetooth list and try pairing again.

• Restart both the headset and your device.

9.3 No Sound / Poor Sound Quality

- Check the volume levels on both the headset and your connected device.
- Ensure the headset is properly connected (either via Bluetooth or the 3.5mm wired cable).
- If using Bluetooth, ensure you are within the effective wireless range.
- For wired connection, ensure the 3.5mm cable is fully inserted into both the headset and your device.

9.4 Microphone Not Working

- Ensure the boom microphone is properly positioned near your mouth.
- Check microphone input settings on your connected device to ensure the headset is selected as the audio input device.




