
IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using your Westinghouse Electric Heated Blanket. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or injury.

- Do not use with infants, children, incapacitated persons, or anyone insensitive to heat.
- Never use the blanket if it is wet.
- Do not use with damaged cords or plugs.
- Avoid pinching or folding the heating wires.
- Always unplug the blanket when not in use.
- Do not dry clean.
- This blanket features an overheat protection system for enhanced safety.
- The product is ETL and FCC certified.

SETUP

1. Unpack the blanket and controller from the packaging.
2. Ensure the blanket is spread flat on your bed or desired surface, avoiding any folds or creases.
3. Locate the connector on the blanket and firmly plug in the controller cable. Ensure a secure connection.
4. Plug the power cord into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet.
5. The blanket is now ready for use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off

Press the power button on the controller to turn the blanket on or off.

Adjusting Heat Levels

Use the '+' and '-' buttons on the controller to cycle through the 10 available heat settings. Start with a lower setting and adjust as needed for your comfort.

Setting the Timer

Press the 'TIME' button to set the automatic shut-off timer. You can select a duration from 1 to 12 hours. The blanket will automatically turn off after the selected time has elapsed. This feature is designed to complement manual shut-off.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity and performance of your heated blanket.

- **Before Cleaning:** Always turn off and unplug the blanket from the wall outlet. Detach the control panel from the blanket.
- **Machine Wash:** Machine wash on a cold, delicate cycle. Do not bleach.
- **Drying:** Tumble dry on low heat or line dry. Ensure the blanket is completely dry before reattaching the control and using.
- **Do Not Iron:** Ironing can damage the heating elements.
- **Do Not Dry-clean:** Dry-cleaning solvents can damage the insulation of the heating wires.

NOTE: COOLING BLANKET DOWN BEFORE CLEANING.
DISCONNECT FROM THE MAINS, REMOVE THE CONTROL.

To clean, cool the blanket down, disconnect the control panel, and machine wash. Follow the care instructions for cold wash, hand wash, no ironing, and no dry-cleaning.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Blanket not heating.	Power cord not securely plugged in; controller not connected properly; power outage.	Check all connections. Ensure the wall outlet has power. Press the power button on the controller.
Blanket heats unevenly.	Blanket is folded or bunched up; internal wiring issue.	Ensure the blanket is spread flat. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
Controller display is off or flashing.	Overheat protection activated; power interruption.	Unplug the blanket for 10-15 minutes, then plug it back in. If the issue continues, contact customer support.
Auto shut-off not working.	Timer not set correctly; malfunction.	Verify timer settings. The auto shut-off is designed to complement manual shut-off. If it consistently fails, contact support.
