It can differentiate between people, packages, animals, and vehicles, sending relevant notifications directly to your Google Home app.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and follow all safety guidelines to prevent risk of overheating, burns, fire, and shock. The device is designed to operate between -4°F and 104°F (-20°C and 40°C). Do not paint or place a cover on the doorbell. Ensure proper wiring if connecting to existing doorbell wires. Install in accordance with local building and installation regulations.

SETUP

The Google Nest Doorbell (Battery) offers flexible installation options, either wire-free using its built-in battery or connected to existing doorbell wires. The Google Home app is required for setup and operation.

2. Physical Installation

Choose your preferred installation method: wire-free or wired. For wire-free installation, simply mount the doorbell to your desired location using the provided base plate, wall anchors, and screws. For wired installation, connect the doorbell to your existing doorbell wires using the included wire connector. Ensure power is off at the breaker before handling any wiring.

1. Download the Google Home app from your device's app store.
2. Create or log in to your Google account.
3. In the app, tap the '+' icon to add a new device.

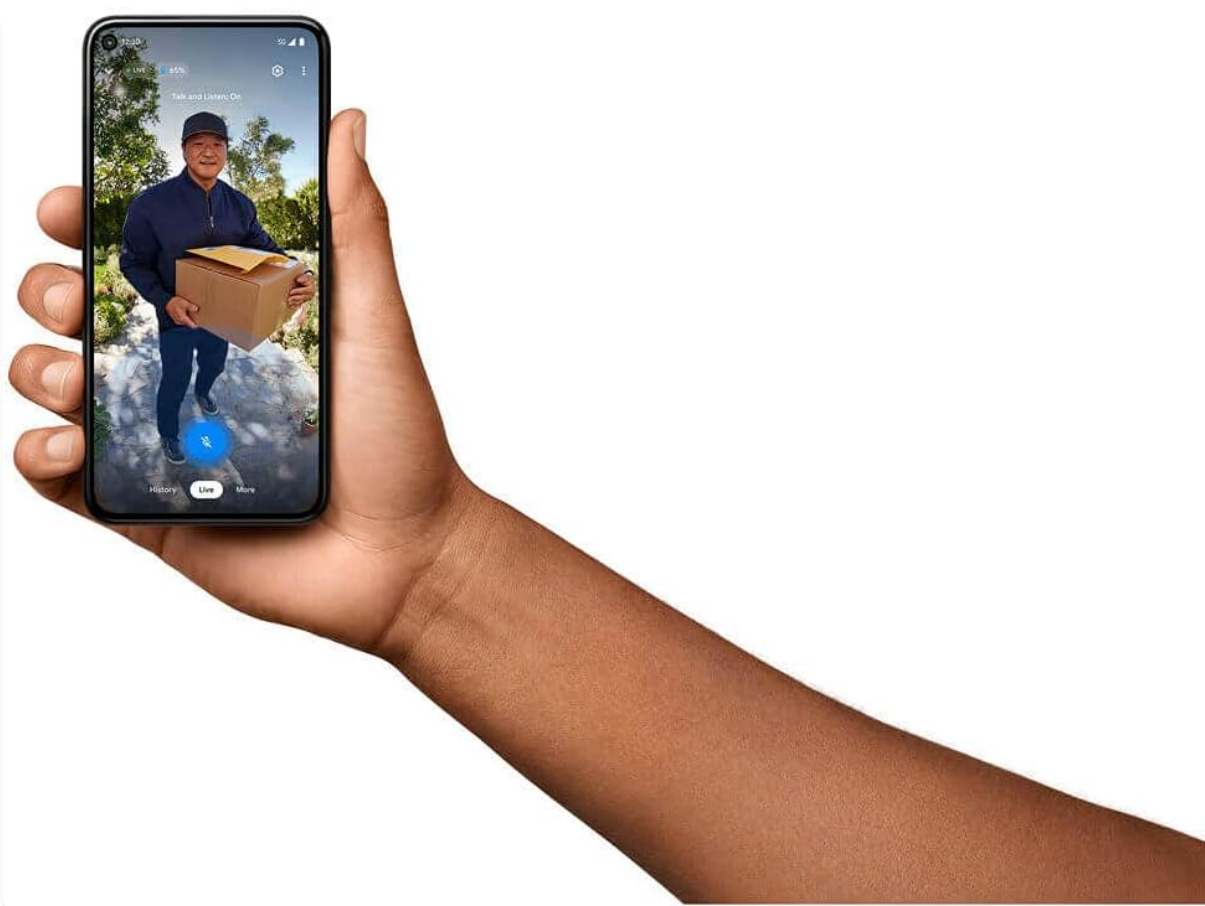

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Nest Doorbell provides advanced monitoring capabilities and seamless interaction through the Google Home app.

1. Intelligent Alerts and Live View

The doorbell uses built-in intelligence to distinguish between people, packages, animals, and vehicles, sending specific alerts to your phone. You can access a live HD video feed with HDR and night vision at any time through the Google Home app.

This video demonstrates how the Google Nest Doorbell allows you to see who is at your door before they ring, enhancing security and convenience.

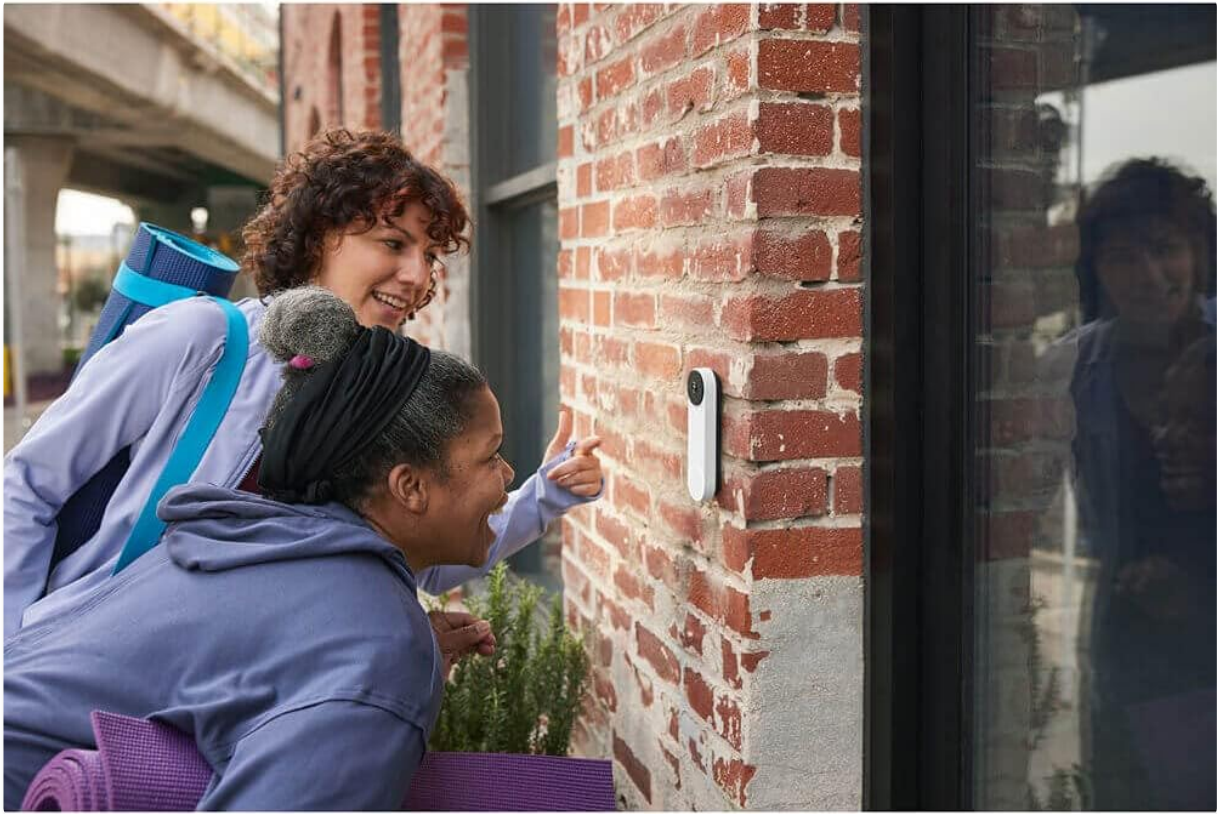
MAINTENANCE

1. Battery Charging

For the battery-powered model, periodically charge the device using the provided charge cable. The battery life varies based on activity, temperature, and settings. The Google Home app will indicate the current battery level.

2. Weather Resistance

The Nest Doorbell has an IP54 international protection rating, making it resistant to dust and splashes of water. It is designed for outdoor use and can withstand various weather conditions.

TROUBLESHOOTING

1. Wi-Fi or Power Outage

If your Wi-Fi goes down or there's a power outage, the Nest Doorbell will store up to 1 hour of recorded events locally, allowing you to review what you missed once connectivity is restored.

2. App Compatibility

The Nest Doorbell requires the Google Home app and a free Google account. It is not compatible with the older Nest app or the Nest website.

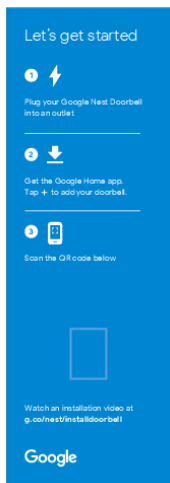

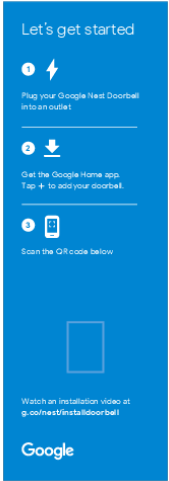

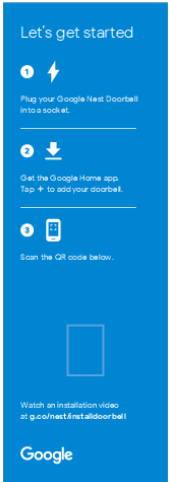
