INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Moultrie W800 All-Purpose Series A Trail Camera. Please read this guide thoroughly to ensure proper use and optimal performance of your device.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Moultrie W800 is a high-performance trail camera designed for capturing images and videos of wildlife. It features an Illumi-Night Sensor for clear nighttime captures and a robust design for outdoor use.

- Captures 26 Megapixel images for high clarity.
- 70-foot flash and detection range.
- Fast 0.5 second trigger speed.




Image: Moultrie W800 Trail Camera in its retail packaging, showing the camera, batteries, and key features on the box.

SETUP

1. Battery Installation

1. Open the camera housing latch.
2. Insert 8 AA batteries into the battery compartment, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
3. Close the camera housing latch securely.

2. SD Card Installation

1. With the camera housing open, locate the SD card slot.

2. Insert a standard SD card (up to 32GB) into the slot until it clicks into place. Ensure the card is inserted in the correct orientation.
3. It is recommended to format the SD card using the camera's menu settings before first use.

3. Mounting the Camera

1. Select a suitable location, typically a tree or post, where the camera can capture the desired area.
2. Mount the camera approximately 3-5 feet above the ground.
3. Use the provided mounting strap to secure the camera firmly. Thread the strap through the camera's mounting slots and tighten it around the object.
4. Angle the camera to avoid direct sunlight and to minimize false triggers from swaying branches.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Operation

1. **Power On/Off:** Locate the power switch inside the camera housing. Slide it to the 'ON' position to power on the camera. Slide to 'OFF' to power off.
2. **Setup Mode:** After powering on, the camera will typically enter 'SETUP' mode. In this mode, you can adjust settings such as date, time, photo/video mode, resolution, and trigger delay using the control buttons and display.
3. **Arming the Camera:** Once settings are configured, slide the power switch to the 'ARM' position. The camera will initiate a countdown (e.g., 10 seconds) to allow you to leave the area without triggering a capture. After the countdown, the camera will be active and ready to detect motion.
4. **Checking Status:** The small display inside the camera housing provides status information, including battery level, SD card status, and current mode.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Periodically clean the camera lens and sensor window with a soft, lint-free cloth. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.
- **Battery Check:** Regularly check battery levels, especially before extended deployment. Replace all batteries simultaneously to ensure consistent power.
- **SD Card Management:** Format the SD card regularly to prevent data corruption and ensure optimal performance. Back up important images/videos before formatting.
- **Housing Integrity:** Ensure the camera housing latch is always securely closed to protect against moisture and dust.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Camera not taking pictures:

- Check if the camera is in 'ARM' mode.
- Ensure the SD card is properly inserted and has sufficient free space.
- Verify that batteries have adequate charge.
- Check camera settings for trigger delay or sensitivity.
- Format the SD card.

Poor image quality:

- Clean the camera lens and sensor window.
- Ensure the camera is mounted at the recommended height and angle.
- Check for obstructions in front of the camera.

Short battery life:

- Use fresh, high-quality alkaline or lithium AA batteries.
- Extreme temperatures can affect battery performance.
- Frequent video recording or high trigger frequency can consume more power.
