## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The OMOTON Bluetooth Keyboard is a versatile and ultra-slim wireless keyboard designed for seamless compatibility with a wide range of iPad devices, including iPad Pro 13/11 inch 2024, iPad Air 13/11 inch 2024, iPad 10th Generation (10.9 inch), iPad 10.2 inch (9th/8th/7th generation), iPad Pro 11/12.9, iPad Air 10.9/10.5, iPad 9.7, and iPad Mini series. It features a built-in 400mAh lithium battery for extended use, illuminated LED backlighting with 7 adjustable colors and 3 brightness levels, and effective shortcut keys for enhanced productivity. Its lightweight and compact design make it highly portable, providing a comfortable and quiet typing experience.

## SETUP GUIDE

### 1. Charging the Keyboard

Before initial use, ensure the keyboard is fully charged. Connect the provided USB cable to the charging port on the keyboard and to a USB power source (e.g., computer, USB wall adapter). The charge indicator light will illuminate during charging. A full charge takes approximately 3 hours and provides over 40 hours of working time.

## 2. Bluetooth Pairing

1. **Power On:** Locate the ON/OFF switch on the top right side of the keyboard and slide it to the "ON" position. The power indicator light will turn on.
2. **Activate Pairing Mode:** Press the "Connect" button located next to the ON/OFF switch. The Bluetooth indicator light will start blinking, indicating the keyboard is in pairing mode.
3. **Enable Bluetooth on your iPad:** Go to your iPad's "Settings" app, then tap on "Bluetooth". Make sure Bluetooth is toggled "On".
4. **Select Keyboard:** Your iPad will search for nearby Bluetooth devices. Look for "Bluetooth Keyboard" (or a similar name like "OMOTON Keyboard") in the list of "Other Devices" and tap on it.
5. **Confirm Connection:** Your iPad may display a pairing code. Type this code on the OMOTON keyboard and press **Enter**. Once successfully paired, the Bluetooth indicator light on the keyboard will stop blinking and remain solid, and your iPad will show "Connected" next to the keyboard's name.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 1. Using the Backlight Function

- **Turn On/Off Backlight:** Press the **light bulb icon key** (usually located near the bottom right of the keyboard) once to turn on the backlight. Press it a second time to activate the breathing light effect. Press it a third time to turn off the backlight.
- **Change Backlight Color:** Press the **RGB icon key** (next to the light bulb icon) to cycle through the 7 available backlight colors (e.g., blue, green, red, purple, yellow, cyan, white).
- **Adjust Brightness:** Use the **Fn + light bulb icon key** (up arrow) to increase brightness and **Fn + light bulb icon key** (down arrow) to decrease brightness. There are 3 levels of brightness.

## 2. Using Shortcut Keys

The keyboard is equipped with multimedia shortcut keys for convenient operation. These keys are typically accessed by pressing the **Fn** key in combination with the corresponding function key (F1-F12).

- **Fn + F1:** Home Screen
- **Fn + F2:** Search
- **Fn + F3:** Select All
- **Fn + F4:** Copy
- **Fn + F5:** Paste
- **Fn + F6:** Cut
- **Fn + F7:** Previous Track
- **Fn + F8:** Play/Pause
- **Fn + F9:** Next Track
- **Fn + F10:** Mute Volume
- **Fn + F11:** Volume Down



- **Fn + F12:** Volume Up
- **Caps Lock:** The CAPS indicator light on the keyboard will illuminate when Caps Lock is active.

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the keyboard. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild cleaning solution. Avoid excessive moisture.
- **Storage:** Store the keyboard in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Avoid Liquids:** Do not expose the keyboard to liquids, as this can cause damage to internal components.
- **Handle with Care:** While durable, avoid dropping the keyboard or subjecting it to strong impacts.
- **Non-Slip Mat:** The keyboard features non-slip mats on the bottom to prevent slipping during use. Ensure these are clean and intact for optimal stability.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### Keyboard Not Connecting/Pairing:

- Ensure the keyboard is powered on and fully charged.
- Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your iPad.
- Press the "Connect" button on the keyboard to enter pairing mode.
- If the keyboard was previously paired with another device, disconnect it from that device first.
- Try forgetting the device on your iPad's Bluetooth settings and re-pairing.
- Restart both your iPad and the keyboard.

### Keys Not Responding:

- Check the keyboard's battery level. Recharge if necessary.
- Ensure the keyboard is still connected via Bluetooth to your iPad.
- Restart the keyboard and your iPad.
- Clean around the keys to ensure no debris is obstructing them.

### Backlight Not Working/Changing:

- Ensure the keyboard is powered on.
- Press the light bulb icon key to cycle through backlight modes.
- Press the RGB icon key to change colors.
- Adjust brightness using Fn + light bulb icon key (up/down arrows).
- If the battery is very low, the backlight might not function or might be dim. Charge the keyboard.
