# JUAREZ JRK663 61-Key Light-Up Piano Electronic Keyboard

## INSTRUCTION MANUAL

### 1. Introduction

---

Thank you for purchasing the JUAREZ JRK663 61-Key Light-Up Piano Electronic Keyboard. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your new instrument. Please read it thoroughly before operation and retain it for future reference.

### 2. Safety Information

---

- Do not expose the keyboard to water, moisture, or extreme temperatures.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the keyboard.
- Use only the specified power adapter.
- Keep out of reach of small children to prevent choking hazards from small parts.
- Disconnect power during thunderstorms or when not in use for extended periods.

### 4. Product Overview

---

The JUAREZ JRK663 is a versatile 61-key electronic keyboard designed for beginners and casual musicians. It features light-up keys for interactive learning and a comprehensive set of functions.

## Key Features:

- **61 Piano-Style Light-Up Keys:** Aids in visual learning and practice.
- **LED Display:** Provides visual feedback for selected functions.
- **350 Timbres:** A wide selection of instrument sounds.
- **350 Rhythms:** Various backing beats for diverse musical styles.
- **30 Demo Songs:** Pre-recorded songs for listening and practice.
- **3 Teaching Modes:** Structured lessons for progressive learning.
- **61 Keyboard Percussion Sounds:** Integrated percussion effects on keys.
- **8 Panel Percussion Options:** Dedicated percussion pads.
- **Record/Playback Function:** For capturing and reviewing performances.
- **External Earphone/Microphone/Audio Input:** Connectivity for accessories.

## 5. Setup

---

### 5.1 Power Connection

1. Ensure the keyboard is switched off.
2. Connect the power adapter to the DC IN jack on the keyboard.
3. Plug the power adapter into a standard electrical outlet.

### 5.2 Connecting Accessories

- **Microphone:** Insert the microphone plug into the MIC IN jack.
- **Headphones:** Connect headphones to the PHONES/OUTPUT jack for private practice.
- **External Audio Device:** Connect an external audio source (e.g., MP3 player) to the AUDIO IN jack to play along with music.

## 6. Operating Instructions

---

### 6.1 Power On/Off and Volume

- Press the **POWER** button to turn the keyboard on or off.
- Adjust the master volume using the **VOLUME +/-** buttons or knob.

## 6.2 Selecting Timbres (Instrument Sounds)

The keyboard offers 350 different timbres. To select a timbre:

1. Press the **TIMBRE** button.
2. Use the number pad or +/- buttons to enter the desired timbre number (000-349).
3. The selected timbre will be displayed on the LED screen.

## 6.3 Selecting Rhythms (Backing Beats)

Choose from 350 rhythms to accompany your playing:

1. Press the **RHYTHM** button.
2. Use the number pad or +/- buttons to enter the desired rhythm number (000-349).
3. Press **START/STOP** to begin or end the rhythm.
4. Adjust the rhythm tempo using the **TEMPO +/-** buttons.

## 6.4 Playing Demo Songs

The keyboard includes 30 demo songs:

1. Press the **DEMO** button.
2. Use the +/- buttons to cycle through the demo songs.
3. Press **DEMO** again to play the selected song. Press **START/STOP** to stop.

## 6.5 Teaching Modes

The JRK663 features 3 teaching modes to assist with learning:

- Consult the specific teaching mode buttons (e.g., **ONE KEY**, **FOLLOW**, **ENSEMBLE**) and follow the on-screen prompts or light-up keys.
- These modes guide you through playing demo songs or exercises.

## 6.6 Recording and Playback

To record your performance:

1. Press the **RECORD** button. The LED display will indicate recording mode.
2. Play your desired melody.
3. Press **PLAY** to listen to your recorded performance.

## 6.7 Percussion Features

- **Keyboard Percussion:** Activate the percussion mode to assign various percussion sounds to the keys.
- **Panel Percussion:** Use the dedicated 8 panel percussion pads for additional drum sounds.

## 6.8 Other Functions

- **Chord Control:** Engage single-finger or fingered chord modes.
- **Vibrato & Sustain:** Add effects to your notes.
- **Metronome:** Use the built-in metronome for timing practice.

## 7. Maintenance

---

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the keyboard with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the keyboard in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and dust.

- **Transportation:** When moving the keyboard, ensure it is powered off and all cables are disconnected.

## 8. Troubleshooting

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound	Volume too low; headphones connected; power issue.	Increase volume; disconnect headphones; check power connection.
Keys not lighting up	Light-up feature disabled; teaching mode not active.	Check settings for light-up keys; activate a teaching mode.
Rhythm not playing	Rhythm not selected; START/STOP not pressed.	Select a rhythm; press START/STOP.
