PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The BAIDE HOME Borosilicate Glass Wind Shield is designed to enhance the safety and performance of your patio gas fire column. Made from high-quality borosilicate glass with polished edges and sturdy aluminum holders, this wind shield effectively protects the flame from wind, ensuring a steady and enjoyable fire. It is specifically designed for BAIDE HOME fire column series.

Dimensions: 11.81" x 11.81" x 4.5" with a thickness of 1/3" (8mm).

- Borosilicate Glass Panels (typically 4 panels for round shields)
- Aluminum Holders (3 or 4, depending on design)
- Screws and Screwdriver (for assembly)

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to assemble your Borosilicate Glass Wind Shield:

1. **Prepare the Surface:** Place the glass panels on a clean, flat, and stable surface to prevent scratches or damage during assembly.
2. **Attach Top Holders:** Assemble the glass top holders to two adjacent glass panels using the provided bolts. Loosely tighten them with a screwdriver.
3. **Connect Remaining Panels:** Continue to connect the remaining glass panels using the top and bottom holders, ensuring they form a circular shape. Loosely tighten all bolts.
4. **Final Tightening:** Once all panels are in place and the circular shape is formed, carefully tighten all bolts securely. Do not overtighten to avoid cracking the glass.
5. **Placement:** Carefully place the assembled wind shield onto your BAIDE HOME patio gas fire column, ensuring it sits securely around the burner area.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The wind shield is a passive accessory designed to improve flame stability. Its operation is directly tied to the fire pit's controls.

1. **Before Lighting:** Ensure the wind shield is securely placed on the fire pit. Verify that the propane tank is correctly connected and the gas valve is open.
2. **Lighting the Fire Pit:** Follow your fire pit's specific lighting instructions. Typically, this involves pushing and turning the control knob to the "ON" position and pressing the igniter button.
3. **Adjusting Flame:** Once lit, adjust the flame height using the fire pit's control knob as desired. The wind shield will help maintain a consistent flame even in breezy conditions.
4. **Turning Off:** To turn off the fire pit, turn the control knob to the "OFF" position. Close the gas supply valve on the propane tank. Allow the fire pit and wind shield to cool completely before handling.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your wind shield.

- **Cleaning:** Allow the glass wind shield to cool completely before cleaning. Use a soft cloth and a mild glass cleaner. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as they can scratch the glass.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the glass panels for any cracks or chips. Check the aluminum holders and screws for tightness and corrosion. Replace any damaged components immediately.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, especially during harsh weather, it is recommended to disassemble the wind shield and store the glass panels in a safe, protected area to prevent accidental damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues related to the wind shield. For fire pit specific troubleshooting, refer to your fire pit's manual.

- **Loose Panels:** If glass panels feel loose, gently retighten the screws on the aluminum holders. Do not overtighten.
- **Unstable Placement:** Ensure the fire pit surface is level and the wind shield's bottom holders are evenly seated on the fire pit's rim.
- **Scratches/Cracks:** If glass panels are scratched or cracked, discontinue use immediately and replace the affected panel(s). Continued use with damaged glass can be a safety hazard.
