OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

DPI Adjustment

The mouse features an 8000CPI optical sensor. DPI (Dots Per Inch) can be adjusted to change cursor sensitivity. Use the dedicated DPI buttons (usually located near the scroll wheel) to cycle through preset DPI levels. The Bloody software allows for custom DPI settings.

Programmable Buttons & Macros

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the mouse surface. For optical sensor, use a cotton swab lightly dampened with rubbing alcohol. Ensure the mouse is disconnected before cleaning.
- **Storage:** Store the mouse in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Cable Care:** Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling on the braided cable to prevent damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Mouse Not Responding:**
 - Ensure the USB cable is securely plugged into the computer.
 - Try plugging the mouse into a different USB port.
 - Restart your computer.
 - Check if the mouse drivers are properly installed.
- **Inconsistent Tracking:**
 - Clean the optical sensor on the bottom of the mouse.
 - Use the mouse on a clean, uniform surface or a high-quality mouse pad.
 - Adjust DPI settings using the mouse buttons or software.
- **RGB Lighting Not Working:**
 - Ensure the Bloody software is installed and running.

- Check lighting settings within the software.
- Update mouse firmware if available.
