1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

2. **Remove Old Axle:** Carefully loosen and remove the nuts securing the existing front wheel axle. Slide the old axle out of the wheel hub and fork. Keep track of any washers or spacers.
3. **Inspect Components:** Before installing the new axle, inspect the wheel bearings, spacers, and fork dropouts for any damage or wear. Replace any worn components as needed.
4. **Install New Axle:** Insert the new Dilwe front wheel axle through the fork dropout, wheel hub, and the other fork dropout. Ensure all spacers are correctly positioned.
5. **Secure the Axle:** Thread the nuts onto both ends of the axle. Tighten the nuts evenly and securely. Do not overtighten, as this can damage the bearings or fork.
6. **Test Installation:** Spin the front wheel to ensure it rotates freely and smoothly without any wobble or binding. Check that the wheel is centered in the fork.

4. OPERATING CONSIDERATIONS

While the axle itself does not have "operating" functions in the traditional sense, proper installation ensures the scooter's front wheel operates correctly and safely.

- **Smooth Rotation:** After installation, the front wheel should spin freely and without resistance. Any grinding, sticking, or excessive play indicates an issue with installation or bearings.
- **Wheel Alignment:** Ensure the wheel is perfectly aligned within the fork. Misalignment can affect steering and stability.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check the tightness of the axle nuts, especially after the first few rides following installation.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of your scooter's front wheel axle and surrounding components can extend their lifespan and ensure safe operation.

- **Cleanliness:** Keep the axle and wheel hub area clean from dirt, dust, and debris, which can affect bearing performance.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the axle for any signs of bending, corrosion, or damage. Check the nuts for stripping or wear.
- **Bearing Health:** The axle works in conjunction with the wheel bearings. If the wheel feels rough or makes noise when spinning, the bearings may need cleaning, lubrication, or replacement.
- **Tightness Check:** Regularly check that the axle nuts are securely tightened to the manufacturer's specifications (if available for your scooter model).

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues that may arise with the front wheel axle.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Wheel wobbles or has excessive play.	Axle nuts are loose; worn wheel bearings; incorrect spacers.	Tighten axle nuts; inspect and replace bearings if necessary; ensure correct spacer placement.
Wheel does not spin freely or makes grinding noise.	Overtightened axle nuts; damaged or dirty bearings; axle bent.	Loosen nuts slightly (if overtightened); clean or replace bearings; inspect axle for damage and replace if bent.
Axle difficult to install.	Misalignment of wheel/fork; incorrect axle size.	Ensure wheel is properly seated in fork dropouts; verify axle is the correct size for your scooter (8-inch wheel compatibility).
